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Commissioners Report

To the Residents of Rye Beach Village District:

This year our surplus is quite high, once again, for essentially the same reason as last year, that being work that was budgeted but not accomplished. In the case of the paving of the precinct building driveway, it was deemed advisable to have a survey done to insure a proper gradient. By the time this was finished, it was too late to pave so this will be done this year.

Repairs to the precinct building roof cost less than had been anticipated although some new problems with the drain gutters surfaced as winter set in, too late to correct with 2000 money. Lastly, legal fees were low but this is always a tough one to predict.

We did get a significant stretch of sidewalk on Central Road replaced in late fall but were then advised that spring is the best time for laying concrete so any further sidewalk replacement was delayed until this year.

In June, we contracted with Susan Zarlengo to act as the precinct Zoning Administrator to monitor compliance with our zoning ordinance and to issue building permits. It was thought to be prudent to fill this position from outside the precinct to avoid any conflicts of interest which could occur within the precinct. Her voice mail can be reached at 964-4850

Although we do conduct periodic checks of the precinct street lights, any time that a resident is aware of a light that is out, please call 964-8456 to report it so that we may get the electrician to repair it as soon as possible.

During this past summer, we celebrated the 125th anniversary of continuous service of the US Post Office in Rye Beach. The event was hosted by Sherman Chester, our Postmaster, with approximately sixty people in attendance. The 1933 Rye Beach fire engine was driven down by Chief Blaisdell and displayed on the Rye Beach Common (post office lawn).

Once again, our thanks to the Rye Garden Club and the Rye Beach-Little Boars Head Garden Club for the beautification of the Post Office and Sea Road Circle, respectively.

Article 3: Motion was made to dispense with the reading of reports from Treasurer, Auditor Committees, or Officers heretofore chosen and to approve reports as given in the Annual Report. Motion was M/S/P.

Article 4: Betty Smith was nominated for Commissioner for a three (3) year term. Motion was M/S/P.

New Business: Jackie Gacek sent a letter and vocalized concerns about dog laws governing roaming and animal waste. Discussion was held regarding the upcoming 125th anniversary of the Rye Beach Post Office and was agreed that the community would be invited to participate in the festivities. MiMi and Ned Tate voiced concerns of backing traffic from the Post Office and felt the Rye Beach Precinct clean-up was in need of review. Brad Richards and the community acknowledged John Snyder's many years of service and his resignation, while Paula Snyder commended years of hard work from our commissioners. There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 8:44 PM.
