#### TOWN WARRANT

#### THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the inhabitants of the Town of Seabrook, qualified to vote in town affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall, in said town, on the second Tuesday of March next at ten o'clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

Article 1. To elect a town clerk, one selectman for a term of three years, town treasurer, collector of taxes, three constables, highway agent, three overseers of the poor, and all other necessary town officials for the year ensuing.

Article 2. To see what sum or sums of money the town will vote to raise for the expense of the general government, for the protection of persons and property, for health and sanitation, for highways and bridges, for the town poor, and all other necessary expenditures for the year ensuing.

Article 3. To see if the town will vote to allow the selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of taxes, and to renew and refund town notes.

Article 4. To see if the town will vote to raise the sum of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) to be used toward defraying the expenses of Memorial Day.

Article 5. To see if the town will vote to raise the sum of eight hundred dollars (\$800.00) for the erection of a cement bridge, the location of the same to be left in the hands of the selectmen.

Article 6. To see if the town will vote to raise the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) to be spent on the Rocks Road.

Article 7. To see if the town will vote to raise the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) to be spent on the Post Road west of Joseph S. Woodburn's.

Article 8. To see if the town will vote to purchase a tractor and equipment for highway work.

Article 9. To see what sum of money the town will raise for the purchase of a tractor and equipment for highway work.

Article 10. To see if the town will vote to purchase some fire fighting apparatus.

Article 11. To see what sum of money the town will raise for the purchase of fire fighting apparatus.

Article 12. To see what sum of money the town will raise for the purchase of land and buildings for a garage and storage house.

Article 13. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise towards the observance of Old Home Day, and appoint committees for same.

Article 14. To see how the town will dispose of the income of Common Island, Dow and Bell Marsh.

Article 15. To see if the town will vote to raise the sum of six hundred dollars (\$600.00) for the maintenance of sidewalks.

Article 16. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise to build a foot bridge and sidewalk on the east side of the Lafayette Road, starting at the end of the sidewalk in front of property owned by Roxcy Smith, and go north over Cain's Brook.

Article 17. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for work on White Pine Blister.

Article 18. To see what period of time the town will vote to limit for a discount to be made on the payment of taxes.

Article 19. To see if the town will vote to raise the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) to be paid to the Exeter and Hampton Street Railway Co., in case they show a deficit for the year 1925.

Article 20. To see if the town will vote to raise the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for the purpose of placing a boulder in the Meeting House Green Memorial Park, Hampton.

- Article 21. To see if the town will vote to raise the

sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) providing the State will raise six thousand dollars (\$6,000.00) for the reconstruction of South Main Street.

Article 22. To transact all other business that may legally come before said meeting.
