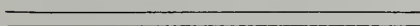

# Warrant for the Annual Town Meeting,

March 14, 1933

## THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

*To the inhabitants of the town of Tuftonboro in the ( L. S. )  
County of Carroll in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:*

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Tuftonboro on Tuesday, the fourteenth day of March next, at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.

2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriation of the same.

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,726.50 for State Aid Construction of its Highway the State to give the sum of \$1,726.00.

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money to aid and assist the Huggins Hospital.

Article 5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,500.00 for the building of a hard surface road connecting the two sections already built on Tuftonboro Neck agreeable to petition signed by Arthur Keenan and others.

Article 6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of four hundred dollars (\$400.00) for the improvement of a portion of cross road so called beginning at the home of O. V. Bennett and leading to Union Wharf agreeable to petition signed by O. V. Bennett and others.

Article 7. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) for the payment of a long term note due February first 1934.

Article 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of four hundred dollars (\$400.00) for the suppression of White Pine Blister Rust.

Article 9. To see if the Town will vote to discontinue a part of the old Wawbeek Road from its entrance on the State Highway to the junction of the New Road.

Article 10. To see what instruction the Town will give the Selectmen relative to the Lake Road at Melvin Village and to raise and appropriate a sum of money to defray any expenses incurred.

Article 11. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of taxes to be raised and collected for the year 1933.

Article 12. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.
