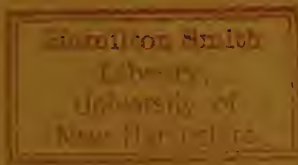

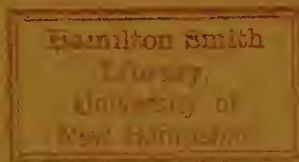

Warrant for Annual Town Meeting Year 1927

To the inhabitants of the town of Columbia, in the County of Coos, in said state, qualified to vote in town affairs;

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said town of Columbia, on Tuesday the 8th day of March next, at 10 o'clock in the forenoon to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose by ballot and major vote a Town Clerk for the year next ensuing.
2. To choose by ballot and major vote one Selectman for the three years next ensuing.
3. To choose by ballot and major vote one or more Auditors for the years ensuing.
4. To choose by ballot and major vote Library Trustees for the year ensuing.
5. To choose by ballot and major vote all other necessary town officers for the year next ensuing.
6. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the support of the poor for the year ensuing.
7. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the repairs of highways and bridges
8. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for winter roads.
9. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the building and maintenance of State roads.
10. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for Public Library.

11. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the up-keep of the cemetery.

13. To hear the report of Agents, Auditors, Committees and Officers heretofore chosen and to pass any motion relating thereto.

14. To transact any other business which may legally come before the meeting.
