Warrant for the Annual Town Meeting, March 12, 1935

THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

*To the inhabitants of the town of Tuftonboro in the (L. S.)
County of Carroll in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:*

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Tuftonboro on Tuesday, the twelfth (12) day of March next, at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriation of the same.
3. To see if the Town will accept State Aid for construction of the class 2 road, known as the Mountain Road, and raise and appropriate or set aside for said purpose, the sum of \$1,768. or will accept State Aid for construction of class 5 roads, and raise and appropriate, or set aside for said purpose, the sum of \$343.04.
4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,000. for improvements and tar on Tuftonboro Neck and Wawbeek Roads.
5. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$500. for legal expenses incurred on Lake Road, and Islands.
6. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$100. for Huggins Hospital.
7. To see if the town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of taxes to be levied for the year 1935.
8. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,000. for the payment of a note due February 1, 1936.
9. To see if the town will vote to install electricity in the Town Hall, and raise and appropriate money for the same.

10. To see if the town will vote to raise the sum of \$300. to remove the ledge at Ledge Hill, agreeable to petition signed by Herbert Ayers and others.

11. To see if the town will vote to raise \$1,500. to rebuild the public wharf at Melvin Village, and to appropriate money for the same, agreeable to petition signed by Ralph W. Drucker and others.

12. To see if the people of Tuftonboro will request the Selectmen to petition the head of the Highway Commission to see if they will remove the triangle plot, and private signs at the intersection of the State Road and Tuftonboro Neck Road, agreeable to petition, signed by Carl B. Johnson and others.

13. To see what sum of money the town will raise and appropriate to build a public wharf at the site of the old Union Wharf at the Lower Bay; agreeable to petition signed by Carroll Lamprey and others.

14. To see if the town will vote to put on two or more crews to run the snow plows and tractor at Tuftonboro Corner, agreeable to petition signed by Myron Haley and others.

15. To see if the Town will vote to accept the provisions of the Municipal Budget Act.

16. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$400. for the suppression of white Pine Blister Rust.

17. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.
