

WARNING OF THE ANNUAL MARCH MEETING 1928

To the inhabitants of the Town of Columbia, in the County of Coos, in said State, qualified to vote in town affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Town of Columbia, on Tuesday the 13th day of March next, at 10 o'clock in the forenoon to act upon the following subjects:

- 1. To choose by ballot and major vote a Town Clerk for the year next ensuing.
- 2. To choose by ballot and major vote one Selectman for the three years next ensuing.
- 3. To choose by ballot and major vote one or more auditors for the year ensuing.
- 4. To choose by ballot and major vote Library Trustees for the year ensuing.
- 5. To choose by ballot and major vote all other necessary town officers for the next year ensuing.
- 6. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the support of the poor for the year ensuing.
- 7. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the repairs of highways and bridges.
- 8. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for winter roads.
- 9. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the building and maintenance of State Roads.
- 10. To see if the town will vote to build and construct a new bridge over Lyman Brook on the Meridan Hill Road, and make appropriation for the same.

- 11. To see if the Town will vote to authorize and empower its Selectmen to sell the "Chandler Property" in said Columbia, and being the same property as conveyed to said Town of Columbia by Eugene Jordan, Adm. of the Estate of Frank E. Chandler, late of said Columbia, deceased, and to do any act or thing that may be necessary in the premises.
- 12. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the upkeep of the cemetery.
- 13. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the upkeep of the Public Library.
- 14. To hear the report of Agents, Auditors, Committees and Officers heretofore chosen to pass any motion relating thereto.
- 15. To transact any other business which may legally come before the meeting.
- 16. To bring in your votes for the election of Delegates-at-large, Alternate Delegates-at-large, District Delegates, Alternate District Delegates to the National Conventions of the Democratic and Republican parties, to be held for the purpose of nominating party candidates for President and Vice President of the United States.
