## WARRANT FOR ANNUAL TOWN MEETING

---

### The State of New Hampshire

(L. S.) To the inhabitants of the Town of Lebanon qualified to vote in town affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said town on the second Tuesday of March next at nine o'clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

**First**—To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year.

**Second**—To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the construction and repair of highways and bridges for the ensuing year.

**Third**—To see what sums of money the town will vote to raise for the construction and repairs of sewers and sidewalks for the ensuing year.

**Fourth**—To see what sums of money the town will vote to raise for the improvement of the cemeteries of the town.

**Fifth**—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for the proper observance of Memorial Day.

**Sixth**—To see if the town will vote to raise the

sum of six hundred dollars to provide a free bed at the Mary Hitchcock Hospital.

**Seventh**—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise to assist in the work of the Visiting Nurse Association.

**Eighth**—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for the benefit of the West Lebanon Library.

**Ninth**—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for the benefit of the Lebanon Public Library.

**Tenth**—To see what action the town will take to enable it to secure the provisions of Chapter 35, Laws of 1905, in relation to improved highways, and of Chapter 133, Laws of 1911, Section 27, in relation to the maintenance of the roads.

**Eleventh**—To see if the town will vote to accept the provisions of Chapter 87, Section 1, of the Revised Statutes, on a section of the Mascoma Valley road, so-called, and appropriate, or set aside from the amount raised for highway work the sum of one hundred dollars for this purpose.

**Twelfth**—To see if the town will appropriate the sum of one thousand dollars to control the White Pine Blister Rust.

**Thirteenth**—To see if the town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to hire money in anticipation of taxes.

**Fourteenth**—To determine the division of the school money.

**Fifteenth**—To see if the town will vote to allow a discount on taxes, if paid before specified dates.

**Sixteenth**—To see if the town will continue the inspection of milk, and raise money therefor.

**Seventeenth**—To see if the town will vote to

give prescription permits from May first 1927 to May first 1928 according to Section 99, Laws of 1919, to druggists who are registered Pharmacists doing business in Lebanon, to sell liquors for medicinal, sacramental, scientific or mechanical purposes.

**Eighteenth**—To see if the town will vote to raise the sum of one hundred dollars to hire Rogers & Whitney Park for a playground and to raise the sum of two hundred dollars towards putting the same in suitable condition for athletic games, and to request the Selectmen not to rent the same for circuses, carnivals or other non-athletic purposes.

**Nineteenth**—To see if the town will vote to raise the sum of fifty dollars for the benefit of a playground at West Lebanon.

**Twentieth**—To see if the town will reimburse the Trustees of the Trust Funds to the amount of three thousand four hundred four dollars and eighty-seven cents now deposited in the Peoples Trust Company which is in the process of liquidation

**Twenty-first**—To see if the town will vote to employ a firm of certified public accountants to audit the accounts of the Town, for the year 1927.

**Twenty-second**—To see if the town will vote to build a sewer on South Main Street in West Lebanon from a point near the Boston and Maine Railroad to the Precinct line.

**Twenty-third**—To see what action the town will take relative to the payment of legal and incidental expense incurred in the year 1926 in preventing the Boston & Maine Railroad from curtailing and partially abandoning passenger, express and mail service in and out of the Town of Lebanon and pass any vote relating thereto.

**Twenty-fourth**—To choose a Town Clerk for the ensuing year.

**Twenty-fifth**—To choose one Selectman for the

ensuing three years, Overseer of the Poor, Collector of Taxes, Highway Agent, and all other necessary town officers for the ensuing year.

**Twenty-sixth**—To choose a Trustee to administer the Trust Funds of the town for three years.

The Board of Selectmen of Lebanon, N. H.:

In accordance with your instructions we have audited the accounts of the Town of Lebanon for the year ended January 31, 1927 and submit herewith a balance sheet as at that date together with a statement of receipts and disbursements for the year then ended.

We traced all recorded receipts of town monies to the bank of deposit, found that funds disbursed were supported by proper vouchers and reconciled the selectmen's record of receipts and disbursements with the treasurer's cash book.

Cash was verified by confirmations obtained directly from depositories, except that the amount, \$2,664.26, shown by the books as being on deposit in the Peoples Trust Company to the credit of the New Town Hall Building Committee on January 31, 1927, was not confirmed to us by the Board of Bank Commissioners in charge of that bank. We accounted satisfactorily for all other assets, except supply inventories which, because of weather conditions, could not be checked by a physical count.

Notes payable and bonds outstanding as at January 31, 1927 were verified by independent investigations.

In addition to the general accounts of the town we audited the accounts of the following for the year ended January 31, 1927:

Trustees of Trust Funds

Lebanon Public Library

Treasurer of the Lebanon Cemetery Committee

All recorded receipts and disbursements of the foregoing were accounted for to our satisfaction and all funds on deposit to the credit of these divisions on January 31, 1927 were confirmed directly with the depositories. The Trustees of Trust Funds have received a further dividend of 25 per cent. from the Peoples Trust Company on account of funds on deposit in that bank when it suspended pay-

ments. A total of 58 1-3 per cent. in liquidating dividends has been received by the trustees from that bank.

Subject to the foregoing comments we hereby certify that, in our opinion, the attached balance sheet and related statement of receipts and disbursements set forth correctly the financial position of the Town of Lebanon, New Hampshire, as at January 31, 1927 and properly summarize its financial transactions for the year then ended.
