#### **But what does this mean for YOU?**

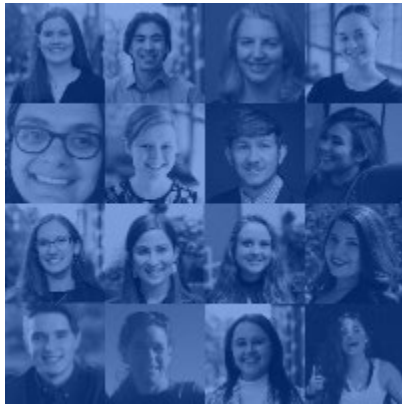
Because we're **growing our partnerships and expanding our offerings**, you have more
