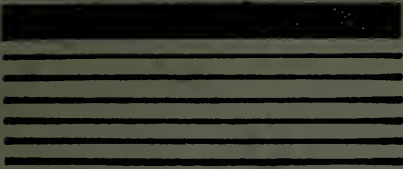


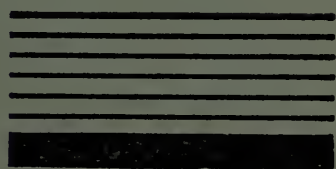

**Warrant for the Annual Town Meeting,
March 10, 1936**

THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

*To the inhabitants of the town of Tuftonboro in the (L. S.)
County of Carroll in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:*

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Tuftonboro on Tuesday, the tenth (10) day of March next, at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriation of the same. (\$7,812.33 figures of Budget Committee.)
3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$100 for the Huggins Hospital.
4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$50.00 for more settees for the Town Hall.
5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$75.00 to install electricity in the Town Hall.
6. To see what action the Town wishes to take regarding the calling of the Wolfeboro Fire Department.
7. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,807.50 the State to raise the sum of \$1,807. for State Aid Construction.
8. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of taxes, to be levied in 1936.

9. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,500.00 for the payment of long term notes due in 1937.

10. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$50.00 to make corner at the intersection of High Street and County Road more safe, provided satisfactory arrangements can be made with the owners of the adjoining property.

11. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.
