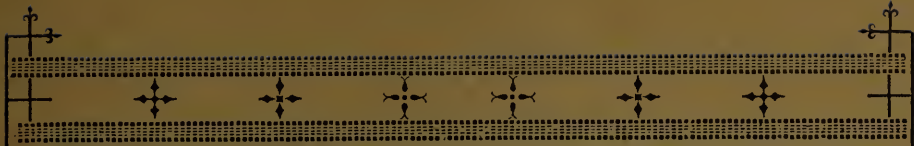

# Warrant for the Annual Town Meeting, March 9, 1937

## THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

*To the inhabitants of the town of Tuftonboro in the (L. S.)  
County of Carroll in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:*

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Tuftonboro on Tuesday, the ninth (9) day of March, next, at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same. (\$8,601.50 figures of Budget Committee.)
3. To vote on the question: "Is it expedient to revise the Constitution?"
4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100) for the Huggins Hospital.
5. To see if the Town will vote to rescind the adoption of the provisions of the Municipal Budget Act.
6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of one hundred and twenty-six dollars (\$126) for the Lakes Region Association.
7. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of four thousand dollars (\$4,000) for improving and tarring the following roads: Tuftonboro Neck, fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500); Wawbeek, five hundred dollars (\$500); the cross road between Union Wharf and Town Hall School, one thousand dollars (\$1,000); High Street and the new Road one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of one thousand eight hundred ninety-one dollars (\$1,891) the State to raise the sum of one thousand eight hundred ninety-one dollars (\$1,891) for State Aid Construction.

9. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.

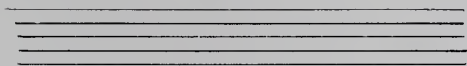

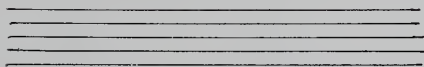
