administration and advising time for UNH and GSC**

1. **Motion presenter:** Chair Rosemary Caron on behalf of the Academic Affairs Committee
2. **Dates of Faculty Senate discussion:** 10/17/2022, 10/31/2022, and 11/14/2022
3. **Rationale:** To align UNH and GSC Spring Break calendar to minimize business operations impact and to ensure that all UNH students benefit from Spring Break.
4. **Motion:** Starting AY 2023-2024, move UNH Spring Break (for all UNH students on the Durham and Manchester campuses) to ensure that it occurs between the 8-week Term 3 and the 8-week Term 4. Following Spring Break 2027, a review of the impact of this calendar change will be conducted by Faculty Senate, prior to implementing the AY 2028-2029 calendar.
5. **Senate action:** The motion passed Faculty Senate at the November 14, 2022 meeting with 44 in favor, 8 opposed.
