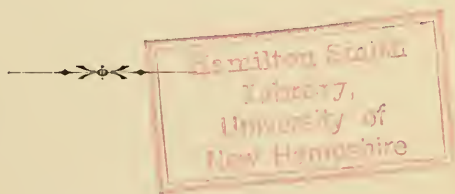

## REPORT OF THE TREASURER.

*To the voters of Sharon :*

I submit the following report in somewhat different form from usual. The reason can be explained to anyone wishing it.

As you are aware, we have had some unusual expenses during the year on account of forest fires, and quarantine from contagious diseases. We were obliged to maintain quarantine for over three weeks, which is the first we have had since the law was passed in 1899.

Then the fire we had to pay for, and one-half the cost was refunded by the State.

We have paid the bills and have some in the treasury.

Have received from the various sources the sum of	\$2,166 12
Paid out	<u>1,917 95</u>
Due the town	\$248 17

The bills and vouchers are placed on file.
