MINUTES OF THE 1974 TOWN MEETING

The polls opened at 2:00 P.M. at the Community Hall, for voting for Delegate to Constitutional Convention.

Town Meeting was called to order by the Moderator, Mr. Stanley Walters, at the Community Hall, on Tuesday, the fifth day of March at 7:30 P.M. to act upon the Town Warrant.

ARTICLE I ELECTION OF TOWN OFFICERS

ARTICLE II

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate \$12,919.00 to defray Town Charges for the ensuing year.

ARTICLE IV - ARTICLE V

Voted, by a large majority voice vote, to combine Summer Maintenance and Winter Maintenance of Highways and Bridges.

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate \$20,000.00 for Summer Maintenance and Winter Maintenance of Highways and Bridges and for any construction of the same for the ensuing year, and including the sum required by law.

ARTICLE VI

Voted to include the General Expenses of the Highway \$800.00, in the money already raised and appropriated (\$20,000.00)

in the combined Summer Maintenance & Winter Maintenance of Highways & Bridges.

ARTICLE VII

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate \$485.10 for Town Road Aid in order to receive the full State's share of \$3,233.99.

ARTICLE VIII

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate \$500.00 to provide and maintain an adequate Public Library service, or to supplement funds otherwise provided.

ARTICLE IX

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate \$1,800.00 for the operation of the Fire Department and the purchase and maintenance of equipment.

ARTICLE X

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate \$3,000.00 for the operation of the Police Department and the purchase and maintenance of equipment.

ARTICLE XI

Voted, by voice vote, to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of taxes.

ARTICLE XII

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate \$188.00 to support the Monadnock Family & Mental Health Service.

ARTICLE XIII

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate \$289.00 as the Town's share for the studies and operation of the Southwestern New Hampshire Regional Planning Commission.

ARTICLE XIV

Voted, by voice vote, to adopt the Australian Ballot system for the election of Town Officers.

ARTICLE XV

Voted, by voice vote, to accept the Bryan Family Cemetery Trust Fund in the amount of \$200.00.

ARTICLE XVI

Voted, by voice vote, that the Selectmen charge for the opening and closing of grave sites, suggested a \$60.00 charge.

ARTICLE XVII

Voted, by voice vote, to authorize the Selectmen to negotiate for additional land to be used for cemetery use.

ARTICLE XVIII

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3,016.50 for the preparation of a Soil Survey, four interpretive maps, and Land Use Inventory. The total cost of the above being \$5,633.00 of which the U.S. Dept. of Agriculture will pay \$2,616.50. If not used this year, the money is to be put in a Trust Fund for future Soil Surveying.

ARTICLE XIX

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$350.00 for a Summer Recreation Program for youngsters, administered by the Conservation Commission.

ARTICLE XX

Voted, by voice vote, to appropriate \$6,000.00 so that the present Town Hall can be converted to meet State Minimum Standards for the Sullivan Library.

ARTICLE XXI

Voted, to table this article.

ARTICLE XXII

Voted, to authorize the Selectmen to appoint a Building Committee to study estimates on construction, and long term bonding for the construction of a Town Hall.

ARTICLE XXIII

Voted to authorize the Selectmen to use \$4,173.01 Revenue Sharing Money for improvements to Town Buildings.

ARTICLE XXIV

Voted to pass over this article as written--current surplus of \$2,339.41 to go to reduce taxes.

ARTICLE XXV

Voted to accept the reports of Agents, Auditor, and Committees, as printed in the Town Report.

ARTICLE XXVI

"Do you favor the construction of an oil refinery in New Hampshire so long as it meets all environmental requirements?"

75% in favor

25% not in favor of the refinery construction.

Article 21--on the table reads as follows: To see if the Town will appropriate \$20,000.00, raising \$5,000.00 by taxes in 1974 and authorize the borrowing of \$15,000.00. \$5,000.00 to be raised by taxes each year in 1975, 1976, and 1977, to be used with any other money available to build a new Fire Station, any unused balance to be put into a capital reserve fund for a new fire truck.

Voted to adjourn at 11:45 P.M. and resume on Tuesday, the Fourth day of June in the evening, at the Community Hall, to act upon this Article, at 7:30 P.M.

Article III -- Delegate to the Constitutional Convention.

The whole number of votes given in was 97 upon which:

John C. Calhoun, Jr. had 10 votes Charles C. Eaton had 23 votes Stanley H. Walters had 63 votes spoiled 01

ADJOURNED TOWN MEETING June 4, 1974

Adjourned Town meeting was called to order by the Moderator, Mr. Stanley Walters, at 7:30 P.M., on June 4, 1974, at the Community Hall, to act upon Article 21, of the Warrant, and to fill a vacancy in the office of Selectmen.

On the fourth written ballot Kathleen Woodbury was elected to the position of Selectman, filling the unexpired term of Raymond Scott.

ARTICLE 21 -- A motion to increase the amount by 10%, so as to read \$22,000., \$5,500. to be raised by taxes in 1974, and authorize the borrowing of \$16,500., \$5,500., to be raised by taxes in 1975, 1976, and 1977.

Voting by written ballots -- Total cast 85.

YES vote 56 NO vote 29

2/3 vote was needed for passage, which was 56.67.

The motion was declared defeated, by the Moderator.

It was quickly moved that another meeting be held in July, to take up the matter, again. This motion was withdrawn, when the Moderator's right to allow a change in the amount of money in the Warrant Article was challenged.

It was moved to reconsider the Article as printed in the Warrant.

Voice vote -- declared undecided by the Moderator.

Written ballot provided the majority needed to revive Article 21, as printed in the Warrant.

The question was moved by a clear cut majority voice vote, so declared, by the Moderator - which reads as follows:

To see if the Town will appropriate \$20,000., raising \$5,000., by taxes in 1974 and authorize the borrowing of \$15,000., \$5,000., to be raised by taxes in 1975, 1976, and 1977, to be used with any other money available to build a new Fire Station, any unused balance to be put into a capital reserve fund for a new fire truck.

Voting by written ballots -- Total cast 83.

YES vote 56

NO vote 27

2/3 vote was needed for passage, which was 55.33.

The motion was declared carried, by the Moderator, as written in the Town Warrant.

Voted by voice vote to dissolve the meeting at 9:30 P.M.

THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

TOWN OF SULLIVAN 1975 WARRANT

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Sullivan in the County of Cheshire in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at Community Hall in said Sullivan on Tuesday, the 4th day of March, next at 7:00 of the clock in the evening, to act upon the following subjects:

- 1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
- 2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same.
- 3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$24,000 for the Maintenance of Highways and Bridges and for any construction of the same for the ensuing year.
- 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$483.08 for Town Road Aid in order to receive the full State's share of \$3,220.57.
- 5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$900.00 to provide and maintain adequate Public Library service, and authorize the Library Trustees to receive and use supplemental funds otherwise provided.
- 6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,000.00 for the operation of the Fire Department and the purchase and maintenance of equiptment.
- 7. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3,000.00 for the Police Department and the purchase and maintenance of equipment.
- 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$300.00 for the Planning Board.
- 9. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$600.00 for a summer Recreation Program for youngsters, administered by the Conservation Commission.

- 10. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to use \$2,296.00 Revenue Sharing money for improvement to Town Buildings.
- 11. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$500.00 for the maintenance of the Town Cemeteries.
- 12. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3,000.00 for the completion of the Fire Station and Library Buildings and Grounds.
- 13. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,621.00, and to authorize the Selectpersons to contract with Keene for the use of their dump.
- 14. To authorize the Selectpersons to borrow money in anticipation of taxes.
- 15. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectpersons to designate a day other than the first Tuesday of March (Election Day) to transact the Town's business.
- 16. To see if the Town will vote to adopt the fiscal year beginning July 1st to June 30th instead of the calendar year we now use.
- 17. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectpersons to appoint the Road Agent.
- 18. To see if the Town will vote to revise the Town Officers' salaries.
- 19. To see if the Town will appropriate \$30,000.00 raising \$6,000.00 by taxes in 1975 and authorize the borrowing of \$24,000.00, \$6,000.00 to be raised by taxes each year in 1976, 1977, 1978 and 1979, to be used with any other money available to purchase a new fire truck, any unused balance to be put into a Capital Reserve Fund for new fire department equiptment, or take any action relating thereto.
- 20. To see if the Town will require all dogs when off the premises of the owner or keeper to be on a leash, or confined in a cage, car, or otherwise, unless the dog is with the owner or keeper and under his control. Hunting dogs to be exempt when properly used for hunting or training.
 - 21. To see if the Town will vote to require a permit before

the construction of any building with an area of 100 square feet or more.

- 22. To see if the Town will vote to require that all livestock and/or fowl be tethered, penned, fenced or confined to a building by owner or keeper.
- 23. To see if the Town will vote to adopt the Ordinance Relating to Campgrounds.
- 24. To see if the Town will vote to accept the agreement the Selectmen made with Bessie C. Jewett regarding land.
- 25. To vote to accept the reports of Agents, Auditor, and Committees, as printed in the Town Report.
- 26. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$50.00 for the Monadnock Regional Bicentennial Committee to enable it to act as a regional coordinator for the celebration of the 1976 Bicentennial.
- 27. To transact any other business which may legally come before said meeting and to listen to opinions of a purely advisory nature in regard to the conduct of Town Affairs for the ensuing year.

REPORT OF THE ROAD AGENT

General Maintenance of the highways included culvets, gravel and ditching this year. Turn-arounds have been made for the snowplow in four places. A total of 3736 yards of gravel was put on the roads throughout the town. Apple Hill, Hubbard and South Roads have been oiled.

An unexpected expense was the building of a new bridge on the Ferry Brook Road.

The State salt shed was rented and stocked with 16 ton salt. Room has been made at the Town Barn to stock pile 1000 yards of sand. Due to the many storms in November, December and January we have already used over 300 yards.

Another unexpected expense was the State Wage Law requiring time and 1/2 over 40 hours for hired help. Added to this the Green Int. Dump Truck Dumped its last load. It was necessary to replace it. Vandalism is on the rise in Sullivan. Seven locks have been put on the Town Barn this year. When they can't break the lock they saw it off. Among other things missing, were one case of anti-freeze within 24 hours after being stored in the Town Barn. The equipment has been vandalized several times and gas stolen repeatedly. The Town Barn seems to be a popular place after dark - all at the expense of the tax payer.

REPORT OF THE SULLIVAN FIRE DEPARTMENT

1974 has been a good year for us. There have been many improvements in the Fire Department. Of these, the greatest and most important was the building of our new Fire Station. After the site was prepared by volunteers who supplied labor and materials, the construction was done by P & N Realty. The Lady Volunteers made a cash donation which was added to the Town appropriation, thus completing the total amount needed for the contract. We wish to express our appreciation to all who have helped make our new Station a reality. There is still much inside finish work and outside landscaping to be done. All help will be more than welcome.

During the summer months, the Firemen participated in a training course which included rescue from a burning or smoke-filled building, using Scott Air-Pacs, fighting oil and chemical fires and learning the types of fire extinguishers. Many films were shown and we learned a lot about fire-fighting and rescue. To test our new knowledge, we went to Meadowood Training Center and took courses involving the smoke-house, pump operation, rescue and field training. Many thanks to Bob Ballou, Wayne Fisher, Charles McDonald and Meadowood for their time and equipment. More training is planned for 1975.

The old Fire Station was cleaned and many repairs were made on the equipment including repairs on the Fire Truck, checking and testing of hose and ladders. Some new hose was purchased also a new extension ladder. Our second Fire Truck was beyond repair so it was returned to Bear Brook State Park and it has been replaced with an Army truck obtained through Civil Defense.

The Lady Volunteers purchased hats, coats, boots and mittens for the Fire Department at a cost of \$1200.00. We also received a donation of boots and coats from the Long Island New York Fire Department. Our thanks to both these organizations for their interest in our safety.

As soon as the radio equipment is transferred to the new Fire Station, we will become a base station, able to dispatch as well as receive. This means when fire-fighters are not able to reach Keene directly we will be able to relay from Sullivan.

We had a successful Chicken Barbecue last summer and plan to have another one this year. We also had a Raffle in December. Money raised has been used to start a New Fire Truck Fund and any donations will be appreciated. This is a very much

needed piece of equipment.

Plans are under way for a Firemen's Ball at the new Fire Station when it is completed, to show our gratitude to the Townspeople for providing us with these new headquarters.

How many have noticed the red light at night on the old Fire Station, which was donated and installed by Joe Fitzpatrick.

CEMETERY REPORT

Progress has been made on the program to beautify the Meeting House Cemetery. There is still much work to be done, such as more head and corner stones to be straightened and leveled also more graves to be landscaped. Vines and brush have been removed from the vault to prepare for masonry work this spring.

Since leveling and seeding two years ago the Old Four Corners Cemetery has been easier to maintain. Potted geraniums placed on the gate post have proved to be a popular addition. Some thought is being given to placing permanent cement urns on the gate post.

A pair of cordless clippers have been donated for the cemetery use by Mrs. Turner.

The only buriels this year were three in the East Sullivan Cemetery.

As you know the common and monument maintenance are part of the Sexton's duties (cost of which doesn't come out of the cemetery funds).

This past year a great deal of landscaping was done including removal of the stump, looming, seeding and straightening the rails around the monument. Materials and labor for this work was donated. Now if we can devise a way to keep the public from driving across our common, we will be able to maintain a spot of beauty in our town.
