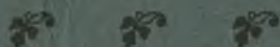

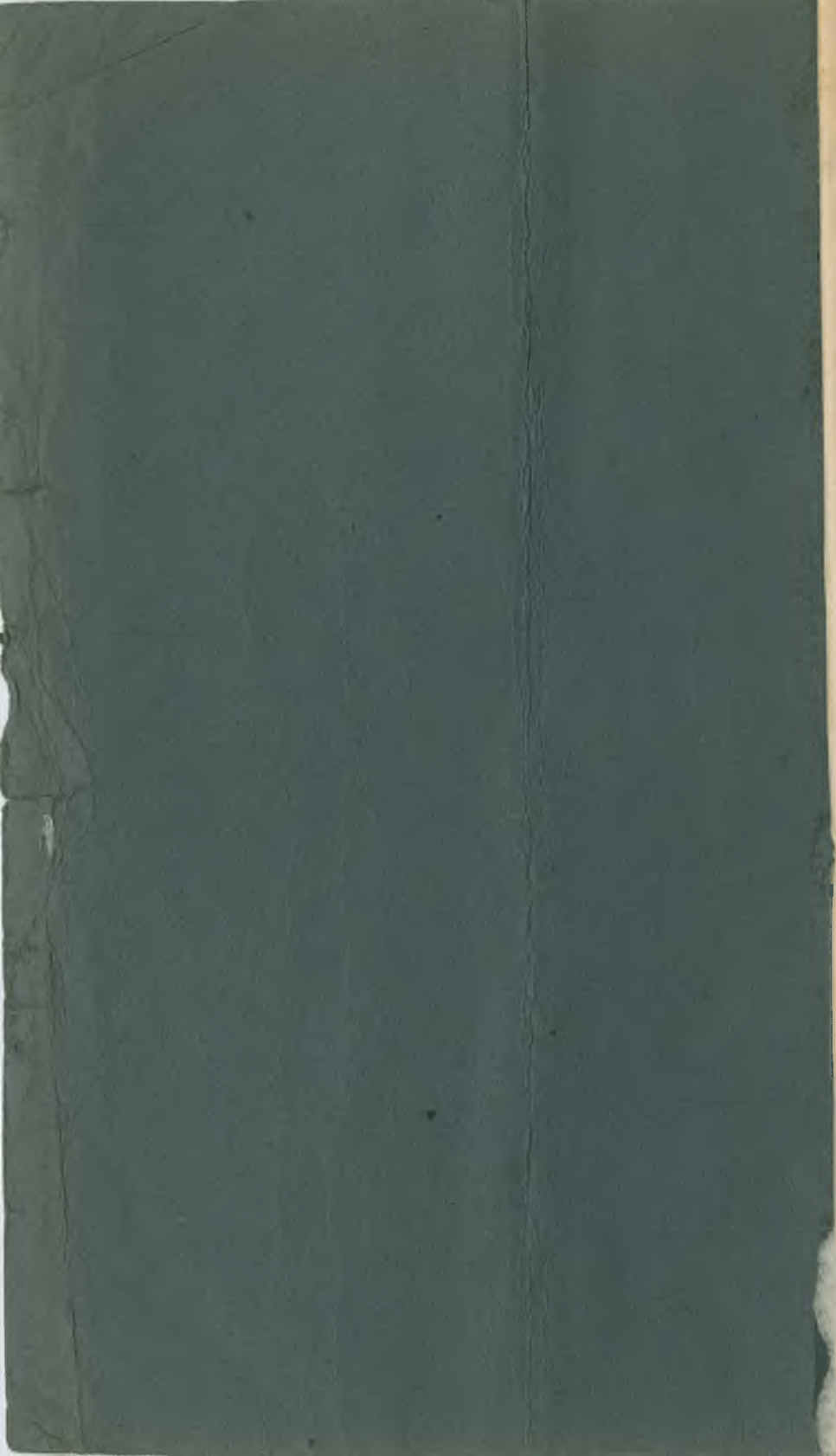

Town Warrant

State of New Hampshire.

To the inhabitants of the town of Meredith qualified to vote in town affairs :

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said town on the second Tuesday of March next, at nine of the clock in the forenoon to act upon the following subjects :

I To bring in your ballots for Town Clerk, three Selectmen, Treasurer, two Auditors, Collector of Taxes and Police Officer.

II To choose all other necessary officers.

III To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the repairs of highways and bridges, and specify how the same shall be laid out. 4000.

IV To see what sum you will raise toward the maintenance of highways under state aid. 675-

V To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for town charges. 500-

VI To see what sum the town will raise to defray the expenses of Memorial Day. 100.

VII To see what sum the town will raise toward defraying the expenses of the Town Library. 500

VIII To see what action the town will take relative to leasing the Town Hall. Selection

IX To see what sum the town will raise for the support of firemen and the protection of property in the Meredith Village Fire District. 400-

X To see what sum you will raise for the payment of outstanding notes against the town. 1000.

XI To see what action the town will take in relation to the acceptance of state aid for highways, and to raise money therefore. 1325. 500-

XII To see what sum you will vote to raise for the purchase of furniture and scenery for the Town Hall. 500. 2000

XIII To see if the town will vote to discontinue such portions of the Ferry Road, so called, on Meredith Neck, leading from the main road by Fanny Lovejoy house, so called, as are not within the layout of the new road, excepting a section about 265 feet in length located about 290 feet from the shore of the Lake and about 675 feet from the main road, said section being necessary to connect the Kelly road, so called, with the new road. Discontinue

XIV To see if the town will vote to purchase a safe for the use of the Town Clerk and raise money therefore. 7100.

XV To see if the town will vote to authorize the selectmen to appoint a night watchman and to raise money to pay the watchman.

# Report of the Trustees of the Meredith Public Library

During the coming year the Trustees of the Meredith Public Library hope to begin the preparation of a complete and modern catalog which will necessitate the reclassification of the library. With the system now in use much valuable and interesting material is lost to the student, and seeker for general information, as it is impossible for any one person to keep familiar with every book. With the card catalog installed, and a new and simpler charging system, a more efficient administration of the library will be possible, and it can take its place among up-to-date libraries of its size. There are soiled and useless books now on the shelves which should be eliminated, and new ones added to fill out weak departments so we may have a well balanced collection of books.

During the past year the library has been enriched by a gift of books from Stanley Erskine, which comprises most of the private library of his father, the late Rev. Justus Erskine, and will be of great interest to Biblical Students. Mrs. Chester Bickford has loaned some illustrated books on

the civil war, which can be taken out by any one interested. Mr. C. C. Whittier has also contributed books on the same subject. Rev. Mr. Pottle has given a year's subscription to the Circle Magazine, and the Meredith News is sent weekly by the Editor. Other friends have contributed periodicals and books.

The usual number of new books have been purchased throughout the year, which include many of interest and value to the thoughtful reader. The use of the library by the students for assistance in their school work is increasing and all possible aid will be given by the librarian. The Reading-room is supplied with the best magazines and periodicals. Books are now sent to Meredith Center each month for circulation in that part of the town.

A fund of \$3000, the interest to be used for the purchase of books has been left to the library, by the late Mrs. Mary A. Ward. Such a gift is a worthy memorial to the donor, and a perpetual benefit to the people of the town, who will always keep her in loving remembrance.

The circulation for the year has been 13,172.

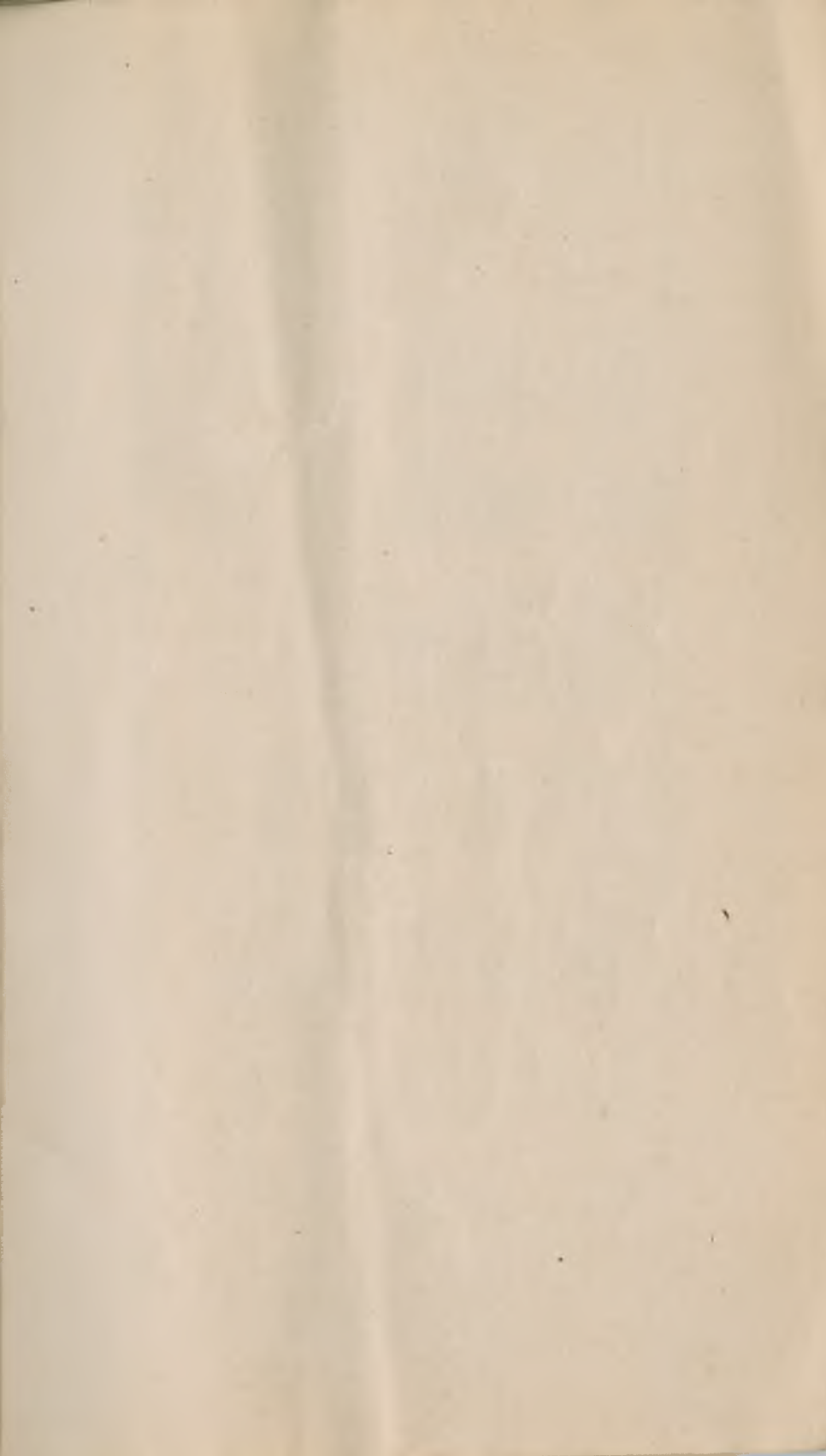

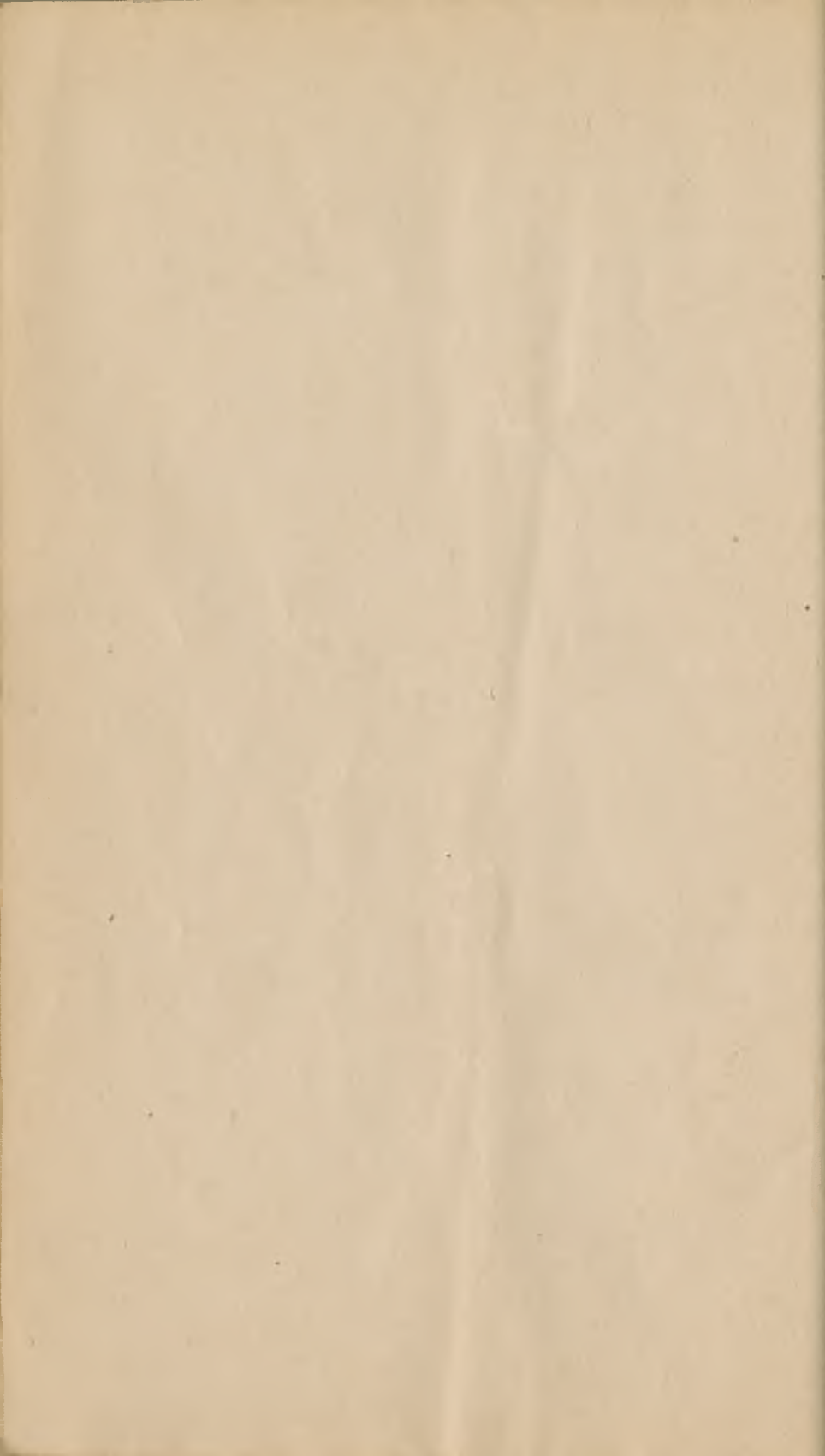
