[FamilySearch.org](https://www.familysearch.org)

- Largest genealogy organization in the world
- Free access to records and trees (sign up for more access)
- FamilySearch Centers allow access to more resources



FindAGrave.com

- Information on last resting places, sometimes with photos, obituaries, and connected family.
- Free! But use judiciously.



WorldConnect

- Hosted by RootsWeb an Ancestry.com property
- Host for almost 500k family trees
- Free access but critical thinking required.
- Crowdsourcing



Google Book Search

- View in entirety, or view snippets and request through Interlibrary Loan
- Excellent source for out-of-copyright texts
- Many local histories and genealogies included
