To the inhabitants of the Town of Carroll, in the County of Coos and State of New Hampshire, qualified to vote in town affairs. You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said town, on Tuesday, the twelfth day of March next, at nine o'clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

 - . Highways and Bridges
 - 1. Road Maintenance, Summer
 - 2. Road Maintenance, Winter
 - 3. General Expense Highway Department
 4. State Aid Construction
 - 4. State Aid Construction
 - 5. Sidewalk Construction and Repairs
 - k. Street Lighting
 Libraries
 - m. Town Poor and Old Age Assistance
 - n. Advertising
 - o. Memorial Day and other Celebrations
 - p. Cemeteries
 - q. Payment on Temporary Loans
 - r. Interest on Loans
- 4. To see if the Town will authorize the Selectmen to borrow money by temporary loans in anticipation of taxes.
- 5. To see if the Town will authorize the Board of Selectmen to administer or dispose of any real estate acquired by the town through tax collector's deeds, or otherwise.

6. To raise and appropriate to the White Mountains Region Association, for its program of advertising, etc., as a part of the cooperative investment by regional towns, an amount equal to 10c per \$1000 of the assessed valuation for 1945.

7. To transact any other business that may lawfully come

before this meeting.
