You are hereby notified to meet at Willey House, New Hampshire in the said town on ~~Thursday~~, March 13th next at nine o'clock in the morning to act on the following subjects:

1. To choose a Town Clerk, Selectman, Town Treasurer, Tax Collector and all other necessary Town officers for the ensuing year.
2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriation of same.
3. To authorize the Selectmen to borrow sums of money as may be necessary on the taxes due the Town of Hart's Location in the year of nineteen hundred forty-five.
4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate four dollars fifty cents for the support of the White Mountain Regional Association.
5. To see if the Town will vote to petition the State Tax Commission to have an audit made by the Municipal Accounting Division and make appropriation to cover the expenses of such an audit.
6. To see what sums of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for snow removal.
7. To see if the Town will vote to raise the necessary money on Town Road Aid, to
