# Warrant

#### THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the inhabitants of the Town of Colebrook, in the County of Coos, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Halcyon Theatre in said Town of Colebrook, on Tuesday, the 14th day of March next, at 10 o'clock in the forenoon to act upon the following subjects:

- 1. To choose by ballot and major vote, a Town Clerk for the year next ensuing.
- 2. To choose by ballot and major vote, a Selectman for the next three years ensuing.
- 3. To choose by ballot and major vote, a Trustee of Trust Funds for the three years next ensuing.
- 4. To choose by ballot and major vote, a Library Trustee for the three years next ensuing.
- 5. To choose by ballot and major vote, one or more Highway Agents for the year next ensuing.
- 6. To choose by ballot and major vote a Tax Collector for the year next ensuing.
- 7. To see if the Town will instruct its Selectmen to appoint all other Town Officers as required by law.
- 8. To see if the Town will vote to approve Town Charges as shown by Budget and raise money for the payment of same.

- 9. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the support of the Poor.
- 10. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the support of the Town Library.
- 11. To see if the Town will vote to build, re-build, remodel, alter, repair, erect, and construct a town house, where the old town house is now located in the southerly side of Bridge Street, in said Colbrook, which was recently partially destroyed by fire; and pass any vote regarding the building, remodelling, altering, repairing, erecting and constructing any building for town purposes, or otherwise, or pass any other vote the inhabitants deem expedient and conducive to the best interest of the town regarding the subject matter of this article, and raise funds therefore.
  - (a) To see what disposition the town will make of the ten thousand dollars insurance money it received by reason of loss by fire to its town house property.
- 12. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the Construction of Highways and Bridges:
  - (a) To see if the Town will vote the sum of \$2991.00 from the completion of the Bungy Road from the East side road to the Columbia town line provided that the State will appropriate the sum of \$2991.00 for the same purpose, it being understood that if said appropriation is made by the State and the town accepts special aid that the Town shall not be entitled to State Aid for Class II roads.
  - (b) To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$719.80 for the T. R. A. construction provided the State will contribute the sum of \$2848.95

for the same purpose and the joint sum to be expended on roads which are designated by the State as T. R. A. roads.

- (c) To see what sums of money the Town will raise and appropriate for maintenance of Town Roads:
- (d) To see if the Town will vote to raise appropriate the sum of \$2000.00 to be used in the plowing of the Town Roads, said sum to be expended at the discretion of the Selectmen in conjunction with the road agents.
- 13. To see what sum of money the Town will raise for the purchase of Snow Fence.
- 14. To see if the Town will vote to buy equipment for plowing roads and appropriate money for same.
- 15. To see if the Town will vote to authorize and instruct its Selectmen to purchase a Grader, so-called, for the purpose of building, grading, and repairing of its highways in said town, and appropriate funds for the payment of the same.
- 16. To see if the Town will vote to furnish electric lights outside of the village precinct as now lighted and make appropriation for same.
- 17. To see if the Town will vote to instruct, authorize and empower its Selectmen to enter into a contract with the Public Service Company of New Hampshire, for the purpose of furnishing adequate light at the westerly end of Colby Street, in said village, and opposite the G. B. Currier Company Store, by installing a 250 watt candle power light, on the electric light pole now set in front of said G. B. Currier Co. Store, and make proper appropriation therefore.

- 18. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for:
  - (a) Sewer Maintenance.
  - (b) Sewer Construction.
- 19. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the observance of Memorial and Armistice Days and the care of monument lots.
- 20. To see if the Town will vote to build a suitable cement curbing along the front of the G. A. R. lot on Bridge street and raise money for same.
- 21. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the care of Cemeteries.
- 22. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise towards the maintenance of a free skating rink.
- 23. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for tarring streets.
- 24. To see what sums of money the Town will vote to raise for construction and repair of Sidewalks.
- 25. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for Police.
- 26. To see if the Town will vote to give free use of Town Hall to Public Schools in said town, for school purposes, including heat, light, and janitor service, whenever such use does not conflict with the best interests of the town, for the year next ensuing.
- 27. To see if the Town will vote to give a discount for the payment of taxes on a sliding scale as follows: 3 per cent for payment on or before June 15; 2 percent by August 1st; and 1 percent by October 1st, for the year next ensuing.

- 28. To see if the Town will vote to authorize its Selectmen to borrow money to defray expenses of the Town in anticipation of taxes, for the year next nsuing.
- 29. To see if the Town will vote to authorize its Selectmen to sell at public auction to such purchasers and for such price as they may determine, any real estate acquired by the Town through Tax Collector's deeds, and until such sale is made to administer such property in the interests of the town.
- 30. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$50.00, said sum to be used in the purchase of small forest fire fighting tools provided the State will appropriate the same sum for that purpose.
- 31. To see if the Town will vote to accept, ratify and confirm the reports of Agents, Selectmen, Auditors, Committees and all other Town Officers as contained in the annual report of said Town for the year ending January 31, 1939, A. D.
- 32. To transact any other business which may legally come before this meeting.

During the year of 1938 we have had no serious epidemics. Several cases of Mumps were reported and a few other communicable diseases. Skin infections, as usual, have been very prevalent, but under the careful supervision of Miss Varney, have been very well controlled, without a great loss of school attendance.

A branch of the State Laboratory has been installed at Berlin and from now on samples of Milk distributed in this community will be taken at frequent intervals and a complete inspection of the production and distribution of same will be made from time to time.

Any persons using water from private springs or wells will be able to have a complete analysis of same by sending samples to Berlin instead of Concord.

#### **GRAVE FOREST SITUATION FOLLOWS**

#### SEPTEMBER HURRICANE

Woodland problems of timber salvage and fire control created in many towns by the September hurricane are of the greatest importance. Good Citizenship calls for personal and widespread action!

The salvage of every thousand feet of logs which can be sold means money for landowners, wages for workers, employment for trucks, teams and machinery, as well as reduced forest fire hazard for all. If owners of windthrown timber have not yet acted, they should communicate with those who can help. Town Chairmen are fully informed; State Advisory Agents can help to start logging by suggesting names of operators and giving other useful advice; Federal Agencies are increasing the number of log storage places as rapidly as possible. Individuals must now cooperate!

Forest fire danger for several years will be greater than usual. So much work must be done by public agencies to reduce hazard along roadsides, near improved and other exposed areas that many places will remain hazardous for some time to come. Individual Landowners must take a personal interest! Aid in clean-up work through the Agricultural Conservation Program is available to any woodland owner at \$4.00 per acre on areas up to 15 acres. The County Agent should be consulted.

Support your local Forest Fire Wardens and Deputies. They are planning, with State and Federal agencies, an intensive campaign to control fires. Help them by strict observance of the fire laws. Kindle no open fires without a permit from the Warden except when the ground is covered with snow. Cooperate by reporting fires you may see and in other ways. Fire fighting tool supplies are inadequate and should be reasonably increased by many towns. You can help, and it will pay, to prevent Forest Fires!
