TOWN OF CARROLL

THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE TOWN WARRANT

To the inhabitants of the Town of Carroll, in the County of Coos and the State of New Hampshire, qualified to vote in town affairs. You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said town, on Tuesday, the fourteenth day of March, next, at nine o'clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To elect all necessary town officers.
2. To raise and appropriate such sums as may be necessary for—
 - a. Town Officers' salaries
 - b. Town Officers' expenses
 - c. Election and registration expenses
 - d. Expenses Town Hall and other buildings
 - e. Police Department
 - f. Fire Department
 - g. Health Department
 - h. Vital Statistics
 - i. Auto Permits
 - j. Highways and Bridges
 1. Road Maintenance, Summer
 2. Road Maintenance, Winter
 3. General Expenses of Highway Department
 4. Sidewalk Construction and Repairs
 5. Town Road Aid
 6. Extension of water line on Whitefield Road from Lemieux' to Cherry Mountain water line
 - k. Street Lighting
 - l. Libraries
 - m. Town Poor, Old Age Assistance and Aid to Crippled Children
 - n. Advertising
 - o. Memorial Day and other celebrations
 - p. Cemeteries
 - q. Damages and legal expenses
 - r. Payment of temporary loans
 - s. Interest on loans
 - t. Insurance
 - u. Printing of Town Reports
3. To see if the Town will authorize the Selectmen to borrow money by temporary loans in anticipation of taxes.

ANNUAL REPORT

4. To see if the Town will authorize the Board of Selectmen to administer or dispose of any real estate acquired by the Town through collector's deeds or otherwise.

5. To raise and appropriate to the White Mountain Regional Association, for its program of advertising, etc., as a part of the cooperative investment by regional towns, an amount equal to \$.10 per \$1,000 of the assessed valuation for 1950.

6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate five hundred dollars (\$500) to be spent through the Board of Trade for advertising.

7. To see if the Town will vote to request the State Tax Commission to make a complete reappraisal of the lands and buildings within the town, to equalize valuations in accordance with the law, and to appropriate money for this purpose.

To transact any other business that may lawfully come before said meeting.

Gentlemen:

Submitted herewith is the report of an audit and examination of the accounts of the Town of Carroll for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1949, which was made by this Division as requested. Exhibits as hereafter listed are included as part of the report.

Scope of Audit

Included in the audit and examination were the accounts of the Board of Selectmen, Tax Collector, Town Clerk, Trustees of Trust Funds and the Water Department.

Financial Statements

Comparative Balance Sheets—Dec. 31, 1948-Dec. 31, 1949:
(Exhibit A)

Comparative Balance Sheets as of December 31, 1948 and December 31, 1949, are presented in Exhibit A. As indicated therein the Net Debt decreased by \$3,515.45 during the year 1949.

Analysis of Change in Financial Condition: (Exhibit B)

An analysis of the change in financial condition of the Town during the year is made in Exhibit B, with the factors which caused the change indicated therein.

Comparative Statements of Appropriations and Expenditures—Estimated and Actual Revenues: (Exhibits C & D)

Comparative statements of appropriations and expenditures, estimated and actual revenues for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1949, are presented in Exhibits C and D. As indicated by the budget summary (Exhibit D), a net revenue surplus of \$1,548.06, plus a net unexpended balance of appropriations of \$1,431.67, resulted in a net budget surplus of \$2,979.73.

Summary of Receipts and Expenditures: (Exhibit E)

A summary of receipts and expenditures for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1949, made up in accordance with the uniform classification of accounts, is included in Exhibit E. Proof of the Treasurer's balance, as of December 31, 1949, is indicated in Exhibit F.

TOWN OF CARROLL

Audit Procedure

The accounts and records of all town officials charged with the custody, receipt and disbursement of public funds were examined and audited. Vouchers and cancelled checks were compared with supporting invoices and payrolls as well as entries in the books of record. Receipts were checked by source insofar as possible and totals of receipts and expenditures verified. Book balances were verified by comparison with reconciled bank balances made from statements obtained from depository banks.

General Comments

Revised Balance Sheet—December 31, 1948: (Exhibit A)

It will be noted that the town balance sheet of December 31, 1948, has been revised so that the Net Debt as of that date is shown as \$7,225.80, rather than \$3,285.29 as originally reported. The increase in Net Debt, amounting to \$3,940.51 occasioned by this revision, resulted from the following changes:

Notes Outstanding:

The notes outstanding on December 31, 1949, in the amount of \$6,000.00, held by the Whitefield Savings Bank and Trust Company, are reported as Temporary Loans in Anticipation of Taxes. Inasmuch as the original loan of \$10,000.00 was made for the purpose of repairs and reconstruction of the water lines, it is recommended that the balance of \$6,000.00 be refunded by the issuance of serial notes.

Town Officers' Expenses:

Detailed statements itemizing mileage, meals and other items of expense of town officers, should be attached to vouchers issued in payment thereof.

ANNUAL REPORT

Conclusion:

The provisions of Section 31, Chapter 211, of the Laws of 1939, require that this report or a summary of its essential features shall be published in the next annual town report.
