(L.S.) The State of New Hampshire

To the inhabitants of the Town of Chatham, New Hampshire in the County of Carroll in said State, qualified to vote in Town affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the town house in said Chatham on Tuesday, the twelfth day of March next, at nine of the clock in the forenoon to act upon the following subjects:

First To hear all complaints and adjust them by vote of the town.

ARTICLE 1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.

- ART. 2. To raise such sums of money as may be needed to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriation of the same.
- ART. 3. To see if the town will vote to allow 2% discount on all property taxes paid before July first.
- ART. 4. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$23.29 to the White Mountains Region Association, it being 10c per \$1,000 of assessed valuation for the purpose of advertising the advantages of the town.
- ART. 5. To see what the town will do in regard to plowing doorvards for the ensuing year.
- ART. 6. To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.

During these post-war days American schools are faced with the problem of improving the standard of accomplishment in the "tool" subjects. The difficulty of finding elementary school teachers remains about as reported to you last year by Superintendent Fuller. The Teacher Training Schools need more enrollees from the towns of New Hampshire in order to meet the normal demand for teachers.
