



## Rhode Island Medicaid Overview

Population<sup>1</sup>: 1,055,607 (2016 Census estimate)

Number Enrolled in Medicaid<sup>2</sup>: 282,368 or 26.8% of population (as of March 2017)

Median Annual Household Income<sup>3</sup>: \$69,972 (2 person household as of 2015)

Has State Expanded Medicaid<sup>4</sup>? Yes

Number and type of hospitals<sup>5</sup>: 11

Number of critical access hospitals<sup>6</sup>: 0

Number of FQHCs<sup>7</sup>: 8 (as of 2015)

### Current Eligibility Guidelines

Provides Medicaid coverage to children up to 261% FPL regardless of age

Provides Medicaid coverage for pregnant women up to 190% FPL

Provides Medicaid coverage to adults who are parents/care takers up to 116% FPL, and to adults up to 133% FPL

### Program Highlights

Rhode Island has a managed care model; Rite Care and Rhody Health Partners (UnitedHealthcare) are the managed care providers in the state. Rite Care is a premium assistance program that pays all or a portion of an eligible employee's share of employer-sponsored health insurance premiums.

After a SIM planning phase, Rhode Island was awarded a \$20 Million 4-year SIM grant in 2016 to improve population health, with an eye on the social and environmental determinants of health, and to align payment reform and delivery system transformation across multiple state agencies and market segments.<sup>9</sup>
