TOWN WARRANT

THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Tuftonboro, N. H. in the County of Carroll, in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at Town House in said Tuftonboro on Tuesday, the Eleventh (11) day of March, next at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.

2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same. \$29,130 figures approved by the budget committee.

3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of six hundred twenty four dollars and forty four cents (\$624.44), the State to contribute the sum of four thousand one hundred sixty two dollars and ninety four cents (\$4,162.94), for Town Road Aid.

4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of one Thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) to lay out on Sodom Road.

5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of two hundred thirty two dollars and sixty cents (\$232.60) for the Lake Region Association.

6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of four thousand (\$4,000.00) the balance due on Town Park.

7. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) for new construction on Union Wharf.

8. To see if the Town will vote to allow the running of public Bingo or Beano games in the town.

9. To transact any other business which may legally come before said meeting.

5. To determine and appoint the salaries of the School Board, Truant Officer, and fix the compensation of any other officers or agent of the District.
6. To hear the reports of agents, auditors, committees, or officers chosen, and pass any vote relating thereto.
7. To choose agents, auditors and committees in relation to any subject embraced in this Warrant.
8. To see what sum of money the District will raise and appropriate for the support of schools, for the salaries of school district officials and agents, and for the payment of statutory obligations of the District, and to authorize the application against said appropriation of such sums as are estimated to be received from the State Founda-

tion Aid Fund and State Building Aid Fund, together with other income: the School Board to certify to the selectmen the balance between the estimated revenue and the appropriation, which balance is to be raised by taxes by the town.

9. To see if the School District will authorize the Board to provide a "late bus" for the Tuftonboro students attending Brewster Free Academy, and appropriate 850.00 for this purpose.
10. To see if the District will vote to authorize the School Board to make application for and to accept, on behalf of the District, any or all grants or offers for educational purposes which may now or hereafter be forthcoming from the State of New Hampshire and/or United States.
11. To see if the School District will vote to hereafter use a check list for the election of the officers, beginning with the 1959 Annual District Meeting, and will adopt as its school check list the town check list, as provided in RSA 197;12A, as inserted by Laws of 1957, Chapter 57.
