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SELECTMENS REPORT

Your attention is invited to the reports in this booklet. These reports give a good picture of what happened in 1985. Our unaudited Financial Report shows expenditures and amounts already committed, such as the Library Oil Furnace, to be about \$1,000 over budget. At the same time income for the year exceeds the estimate made a year ago by more than \$25,000. Motor vehicles and yield taxes were the biggest gainers. We may hope that auto taxes will continue at the 1985 level but it's not likely yield taxes will do as well again.

Like most towns, we saw our property and liability insurance premiums increase. The insurance account for 1984 being \$6,666 rising to \$16,365 in 1985 and we were told we were fortunate to get coverage "at any price". We are exploring changes in coverage and deductibles to reduce this expense while still protecting the town from a large loss.

Our efforts to bring in authorized capital improvements within the funds allotted failed in two areas. Bids for the Town Hall bathroom was considerably over the Capital Reserve Fund set up for that purpose. Quotations for surfacing the rebuilt section of Valley Road were also in excess of appropriated funds. The installation of the Oil Fired Furnace in the Library has been contracted to the Cheshire Oil Company at the figure close to the appropriation of \$2,300.00.

The proposed Highway Department appropriation includes funds for special projects to include surfacing of the new section of Valley Road as well as some shimming and patching on both the Valley Road and the Apple Hill Road.

The Town Hall Committee has reworked the specifications for the Town Hall and will present recommendations at the annual meeting. The committee also invited the State Fire Marshall to inspect our Town Hall. Some of his recommendations involve the expenditure of funds, these proposals will be submitted to you for consideration at the annual meeting.

In summary, we respectfully remind you that our tangible assets, the roads and our town buildings, need continued attention - the funds to keep them up can only be appropriated by the Town Meeting.

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$48,366.35 to defray Town Charges for the ensuing year.

Article 3

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the total sum of \$53,780.00 for the maintenance of highways and bridges and construction of the same for the ensuing year as follow:

\$35,725.00 to be raised by taxes

12,000.00 to be designated from the Highway Block Grant

6,055.00 to be withdrawn from the Revenue Sharing Fund established under the provisions of the State and Local Assistance Act of 1972.

Article 4

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3,850.00 for the operation of the Police Departmen and the purchase and maintenance of equipment for the Police Department.

Article 5

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$7,618.00 for the operation of the Fire Department, for fire protection and purchase and maintenance of equipment and building for the Fire Dept.

Article 6

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$4,470.00 to provide and maintain Public Library service and authorized the Library Trustees to receive and use supplemental funds as provided.

Article 7

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$700.00 for the care and maintenance of Town Cemeteries.

Article 8

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000.00 for deposit to the Capital Reserve for Revaluation.

Article 9

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,500.00 for deposit to the Capital Reserve for Major Highway Equipment Purchase.

Article 10

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$150.00 for rental and purchase of equipment and supplies for Old Home day/Summerfest.

Article 11

Voted, by voice vote, to rescind the 1984 vote raising and appropriating the sum of \$50.00 for annual dues to the Monadnock Region Association.

Article 12

Motion to pass over Article 12 as written.

Voted, by voice vote, not to pass over Article 12.

Voted, by voice vote, to authorize the Selectmen to adopt a deferred compensation plan for employees of the Town and to execute a resolution of adoption with the International City Management Retirement Corporation.

Article 13

Voted, by voice vote, to amend Article 13 -12 members to be appointed by Selectmen.

Voted, by voice vote, to establish a Sullivan Bicentennial Committee for the purpose of planning and coordinating Town's Bicentennial.

Article 14

Voted, by voice vote, to pass over Article 14 - To see if the Town will vote to appoint three delegated to the Regional Refuse Disposal Planning Board to join in the process which is studying the advisability of establishing a regional refuse district under the provisions of RSA 53-B.

Article 15

Voted, by voice vote, to discontinue the so-called "Labadie's Driveway" (refer to #73 on the State maps) length of said road being .06 mile; beginning at the junction of the same and South Road and leading to the house now occupied by the Labadies, and formerly Harvey Swett.

Article 16

Voted, by voice vote, to accept the following Cemetery Trust Funds:

Article 17

Motion to pass over Article 17 was defeated by voice vote.

Amendment--that first the workers get approval for working on the designated holidays from the Selectmen. Amendment was defeated by a voice vote.

Voted, by voice vote, to designate Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day as Town Holidays and establish a policy for compensation of hourly paid employees at double an employee's normal rate for the first eight hours worked on said holidays.

Article 18

Amendment - voted by voice vote, to add by bids. Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,300.00 for the purpose of installing an oil-fired hot air- heating system in the Sullivan Public Library.

Article 19

Voted, by voice vote, to ratify and confirm the vote adopted under Article #4 at the 1984 Town Meeting authorizing the borrowing of \$40,000.00 for the purchase of a new articulated loader and designating the Selectmen as Agents of the Town to determine the terms and mode of financing the amount to be borrowed.

Article 20

Voted, by voice vote, to pass over Article 20. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$317.50 (per capita apportionment) to support the operating budget for fiscal year 1985-1986 for the Southwest Solid Waste Management District.

Article 21

Voted, by voice vote, to establish a Trust Fund and place therein the amount of \$500.00 for the purpose of having a reserve for forest fire fighting liabilities and/or the purchase of forest fire fighting equipment and designated the Selectmen as Agents of the Town authorized to make withdrawals of principal and interest from said trust fund to carry out the purpose for which it was established.

Article 22

Amendment was defeated by a no voice vote - that the Town raise and appropriate \$3,000.00.

Voted, by a standing vote 59 yes - declared unanimous vote-to raise and appropriate the sum of \$6,000.00 for the construction of improvements at the Town Recreation Area (Jewett Park) and authorized the Selectmen as Agents for the Town to apply for, accept and expend 50% funding from the U S Land and Water Conservation Fund - U S Department of Interior.

Article 23

Voted, by voice vote, to authorize the Selectmen to apply for, and to accept, on behalf of the Town, and to expend, any and all gifts, grants or other funds which may now or hereafter be forthcoming over and above the total appropriation of the Town.

Article 24

Voted, by voice vote, to authorize the Selectmen as Agents of the Town to borrow money in anticipation of Taxes.

Article 25

Voted, by voice vote, to accept the reports of the Agents, Auditor and Committees as printed in the Town report.

Article 26

Any one interested in serving on the different Boards, Committees of the Town should contact the Selectmen's Office expressing their interest.

Suggested the print of some reports be made larger in next year's Town report.

You are hereby notified to meet at the East Sullivan Town Hall in said Sullivan on Tuesday, the eleventh (11th) day of March, next, at 1:00 PM of the clock in the afternoon to act upon the following:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing
2. To vote on the following: Are you in favor of the adoption of the ordinance relating to building within the Special Flood Hazard Area as proposed by the Planning Board.

You are hereby notified to meet at the East Sullivan Town Hall on Wednesday, the twelfth day of March next, at 7:00 PM of the clock in the evening to act on the following subjects:

3. To vote to raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray Town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same.
4. To vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$74,100.00 for maintenance of highways and bridges and construction of the same for the ensuing year as follows:
 - \$43,980 to be raised by taxes
 - 23,408 to be designated from the Highway Block Grant
 - 6,712 to be withdrawn from the Revenue Sharing Fund established under the provisions of the State and Local Assistance Act of 1972, or take any action relating thereto.
5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,800.00 for the operation of the Police Department and the purchase and maintenance of equipment of the police department; or take any action relating thereto.
6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$4,857.00 for the operation of the Fire Department for fire protection and purchase and maintenance of equipment and building for the Fire Department; or take any action relating thereto.
7. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3,600.00 to provide and maintain Public Library service and authorize the Library Trustees to receive and use supplemental funds as provided; or take any action relating thereto.

8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000.00 for the deposit to the Capital Reserve for Revaluation; or take any action relating thereto.
9. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,500.00 for deposit to the Capital Reserve for Major Highway Equipment Purchase; or take any action relating thereto.
10. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$500.00 for deposit to the Trust Fund for Forest Fire Fighting Liabilities or the purchase of Forest Fire Fighting Equipment; or take any action relating thereto.
11. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$700.00 for the care and maintenance of Town Cemeteries; or take any action relating thereto.
12. To see if the Town will vote to accept the following Cemetery Trust Fund:
Maurice F. Swett and Helen E. Swett \$200.00
13. To see if the Town will vote to rescind the action taken by the Town Meeting of 1983; wherein it was voted "to discontinue, subject to gates and bars, the so-called Boulder Road beginning at the junction of Nurse Path and leading to Sullivan-Stoddard Town line".
14. To see if the Town will vote to discontinue the section of the Old Apple Hill Road starting at a point 160 feet up the hill from the center line of Route Nine to a point 270 feet down the hill from the center line of the New Apple Hill Road.
15. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000.00 to be used by the Sullivan Bicentennial Committee for planning the Towns Bicentennial; or take any action relating thereto.
16. To vote to accept a gift of \$2,000.00 for Jewett Park from the heirs of Stanley Dvorachek, deceased, and to establish a trust fund, The Stanley Dvorachek Memorial Trust Fund, in the amount of \$2,000.00 for the purpose of additions and upkeep to Jewett Park and to designate the Selectmen as Agents of the Town authorized to make withdrawals of principal and interest from said trust fund to carry out the purpose for which it was established; or take any action relating thereto.
17. To see if the Town will accept the provisions of RSA 53-B:1 to 11 inclusive providing for the establishment of a regional refuse disposal district together with the towns of Chesterfield, Harrisville, Marlborough, Nelson, Roxbury, Surry, Swanzey, Troy, and Westmoreland and the City of Keene, and the construction, maintenance, and operation of a regional refuse disposal facility by said district in accordance with the provisions of a proposed agreement filed with the selectmen.

18. To see if the Town will appropriate the sum of \$764.00 to fulfill the terms and conditions required by the Ashuelot Valley Refuse Disposal District for new members entering the district.

19. To see if the Town will appropriate from current surplus, if available the amount of \$3,500.00 to complete the bathroom facilities in the Town Hall or take any action relating thereto.

20. To see if the Town will appropriate from current surplus, if available, the amount of \$7,435.00 to meet the Fire Marshalls recommendations as concerns the Town Hall:

To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to sell and convey any Real Estate acquired by the Town during the period until the next Town Meeting and that the Selectmen be authorized to sell and convey such Real Estate by auction, sealed bid, or in any other manner as justice may require.

24. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen as Agents of the Town to borrow money in anticipation of Taxes.

25. To see if the Town will vote to accept the reports of the Agents, Auditor and Committees as printed in the Town Report.

26. To transact any other business which may legally come before this meeting and to listen to opinions of a purely advisory nature in regard to the conduct of Town affairs for the ensuing year.

NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS

A new law effective April 1, 1978 imposes a penalty for failure to file a fully completed inventory form.

"RSA 74:7-a Penalty for Failure to File. Any person who fails to file a fully completed inventory form on or before April 15, unless granted an extension under RSA 74:8, shall pay a penalty of one percent of the property tax for which he is liable. In no case, however, shall the penalty be less than \$10 or more than \$50. Any person who fails to file an inventory form and who becomes liable to pay the penalty specified in this section shall lose his right to appeal any matter pertaining to the property tax for which he is liable or exemptions to which he may be entitled. This penalty has all the force of taxation and shall be treated as incident to the tax."

Inventory blanks are mailed before March 25 as required under RSA 74:5, but if for any reason you fail to receive one, you should contact the Selectmen to obtain one and complete it as required above.

The Town of Sullivan still requires the use of inventory forms. Current Use, Veteran, and Elderly Exemptions must be applied for annually on the reverse of the inventory.

It is the committee's goal to make the Sullivan Bicentennial one which will be enjoyable to all Sullivan's residents and friends. We invite your participation in helping to achieve this goal.

ROAD AGENTS REPORT

An analysis of direct highway labor costs for 1985 may give an idea of what your Highway Department does. Summer work such as grading, picking stones, patching, cleaning ditches, culverts and brush removal accounted for 47% or \$11,974. Snow plowing, sanding and salting accounted for 32% or \$8,152.32. The remainder, 21% or \$5,350 was spent on maintenance of Town equipment.

There was no change in equipment this year except for the sale of the John Deere Tractor to the highest bidder. A system has been set up to keep track of maintenance expenses by unit.

The major project in 1985 was done under contract with the City of Keene. The city had scheduled work on their end of the South Road. We were fortunate to be able to contract with them to continue the chip seal treatment up to the top of the hill. Sand is ready for some sealing of the Valley and Apple Hill roads. Funds to complete these projects are included in the proposed budget.

REPORT OF TOWN HALL COMMITTEE

During the early part of 1985, the committee expended considerable effort in developing plans for the inside completion of bathroom facilities -- the exterior work (tank installation, alarm installation, and water source) having been completed in 1984.

Specifications were presented to the Board of Selectmen in September for construction of both stage level and main floor level facilities. Solicitation of bids by the Selectmen's office was unsuccessful because all bids exceeded the towns available funds for the project.

In order to complete the project, additional funding by the town will be required.

On September 24, 1985, a representative of the Fire Marshalls' office toured the building and subsequently has made written recommendations for improvement to the Selectmen. Several of the recommendations require minor construction or reconstruction and will need funding approval by the town.

The building has many needs which have not been addressed, but with favorable action on warrant articles at the 1986 town meeting, the bathroom can be finished and the building will be in greater compliance with Fire Safety Codes.

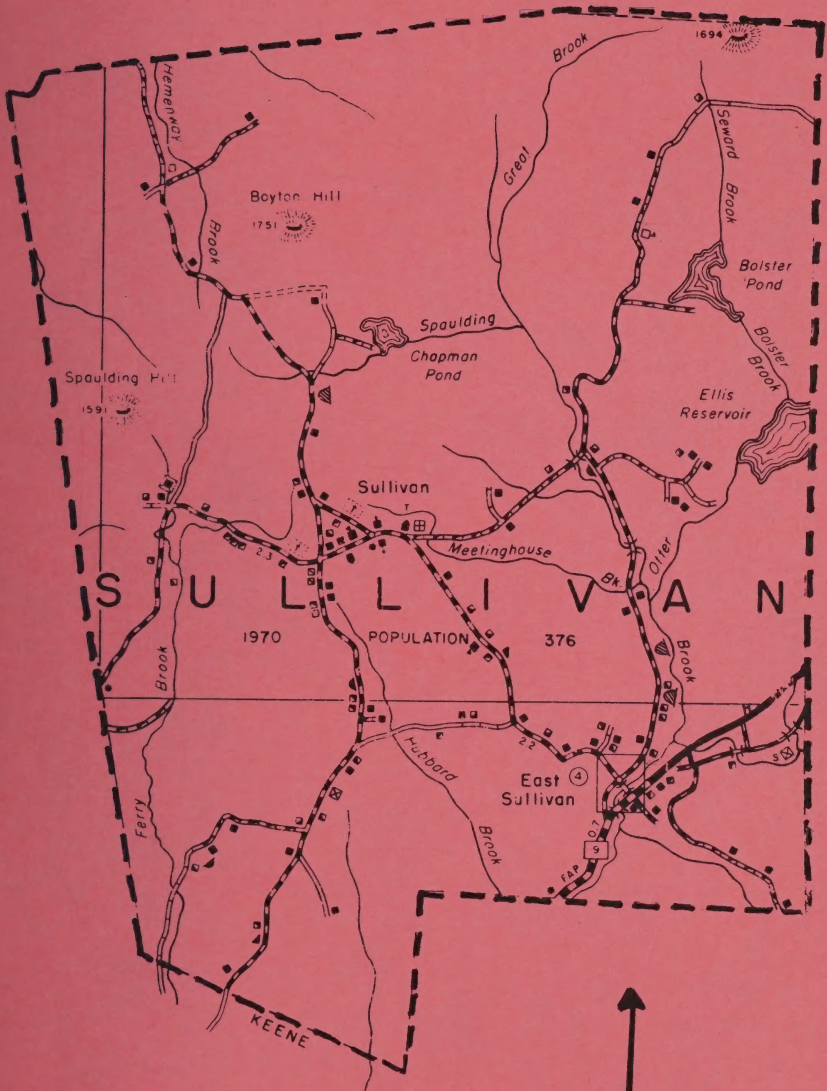
