## Town Warrant

### THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Tuftonboro in the County of Carroll in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town House in said Tuftonboro on Tuesday, the Eighth (8th) day of March, next at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same. \$28,771.16. Twenty eight thousand seven hundred seventy one dollars and sixteen cents, the figure approved by the Budget Committee.
3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of six hundred seventeen dollars and twenty three cents (617.23) for Town Road Aid, the State to contribute the sum of four thousand one hundred fourteen dollars and eighty seven cents (4,114.87), as approved by the Budget Committee.
4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) to improve the Canaan Road to the Ossipee Town Line, as approved by the Budget Committee.
5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$26,000.00 to purchase a new pumper



truck, remodel the present Fire Station, install an approved alarm system and acquire land and build a Fire Station in the Mirror Lake area, and approve such amount thereof which shall be raised by borrowing. (This article inserted by petition and disapproved by the Budget Committee.)

6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$58,480.00 to purchase a new pumper truck, build, and equip a centralized Fire Station, install an approved alarm system and provide full time professional firemen to man the equipment and approve such amount thereof which shall be raised by borrowing. (This article inserted by petition and disapproved by the Budget Committee.)

7. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$19,000.00 to purchase a new pumper truck and remodel the present Fire Station and approve such amount thereof which shall be raised by borrowing. (This article inserted by petition and disapproved by the Budget Committee.)

8. To transact any other business which may legally come before said meeting.
