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### THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Wentworth Location in the County of Coos in said state, qualified to vote in Town Affairs :

You are hereby notified to meet at the Schoolhouse in said Wentworth Location on Tuesday, the 14th day of March, next at seven p.m.. in the evening to act upon the following subjects.

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same.
3. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for the Fire Department.
4. To see if the town will vote to spray for insects, and raise and appropriate the sum of \$700.00 for the same.
5. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for Town Maintenance.
6. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for Old Age Assistance.
7. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for the Water System.
8. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for Civil Defense.
9. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$24.87 to the White Mountain Region Association.
10. To see if the town will vote to buy a piece of land to enlarge the Graveyard, and raise and appropriate money for the same.
11. To see if the town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of taxes.
12. To transact any other business that may legally come before the meeting.

#### THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the Inhabitants of the School District, in the Town of Wentworth Location in the County of Coos, qualified to vote in district affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall, in said district, on Tuesday, the 14th day of March, 1961, immediately after town meeting, to act upon the following articles:

1. To choose a moderator for the coming year.
2. To choose a clerk for the ensuing year.
3. To choose a member of the School Board for the ensuing three years.
4. To choose a treasurer for the ensuing year.
5. To hear the reports of agents, auditors, committees or officers heretofore chosen, and pass any vote relating thereto.
6. To choose an Auditor for the ensuing year.
7. To see if the district will authorize the School Board to enter into an agreement with the School District of Errol to provide schooling for the elementary pupils at a cost not to exceed \$350.00 per pupil per year.
8. To see if the district will require that the School Board put the pupil transportation contract for three years up for public bids at the termination of the present contract, June 30, 1963. Since there is nothing in the records to the contrary it may be well as a part of this vote to authorize the School Board to make a contract not to exceed three years in length. Also, there is nothing in this article to relieve the District through its agent, the School Board, from the responsibility of providing safe and adequate conveyance for its children. Hence

the district through its agent, the School Board, must reserve the right to refuse any and all bids that might jeopardize the safety of the children.

9. To see what sum of money the District will raise and appropriate for the support of schools, for the salaries of school District officials and agents, for the payment of statutory obligations of the District, and to authorize the application against said appropriation of such sums as are estimated to be received from the state equalization fund together with other income; the School Board to certify to the selectmen the balance between the estimated revenue and the appropriation, which balance is to be raised by taxes by the town.
10. To transact any other business that may lawfully come before this meeting.
