## Warrant for Town Meeting

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L. S. THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Ellsworth in the County of Grafton in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the School House in said Ellsworth on Tuesday, the tenth day of March, next at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.

2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same.

3. To see how much money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for the support of highways and bridges.

4. To see if the town will vote to accept State Aid Construction for Trecothic road and raise and appropriate \$54 to secure from the State \$1000, or to accept State Aid for Class V roads and raise and appropriate \$48.62 to secure from the State \$194.48.

5. To determine and appoint the salaries of the town officers and make appropriation for the same.

6. To see if the town will vote to accept State Aid on bridges.

7. To see how much money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for town debts.

8. To see if the town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to hire money in anticipation of uncollected taxes and give notes countersigned by the Treasurer.

9. To see if the town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to administer or dispose of real estate acquired through tax collector's deeds.

10. To see if the town will vote to petition the State Tax Commission to have an audit made by the division of municipal accounting and to make an appropriation to cover the expense of the same.

11. To see what sums of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for fire protection, watchmen, police, town health officers, and board of health to be used due to war emergency.

12. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.
