



Commissioners Report

To the Residents of Rye Beach:

As I sit here on a very windy March evening, I find it hard to believe a year has passed, since I wrote to you. Age, I suppose, when time seems to pass more quickly. But, I hear much younger people say the same. Do you remember when it seemed that Christmas Day and Santa Claus, would never come again? I do.

But, I digress.

2009 was an extremely busy year in the Rye Beach Precinct. Meetings, meetings, meetings! More State forms that have to be downloaded, instead of coming in the mail. And not being able to type on them. Remember, all change is not progress. The RBVD made change AND progress, when, in the early 90's, we installed fluorescent light bulbs in our street lighting fixtures, to light our summer walks. Now, that is called "going green."

Our budget this year is extremely high, because of the Maintenance account on the Precinct building. It came to light last year, after the annual meeting, that the roof of our building, is in need of immediate repairs. So instead of more sidewalk repairs, we shifted money from that account, to the roof repairs. The front section, the worst, was completed. This has stopped the leaks that were beginning to show in the front columns. However, there are many other slates that need to be replaced and the rotten wood underneath them, which are causing leaks to appear in the "great meeting" room. Plus, the cupola has problems and must be taken down, by crane, to be repaired.

Regarding sidewalk repair, we were only able to accomplish a total of 317 feet of sidewalk replacement, all in one stretch of Central Road.

The street lights on the Boulevard and Church Road became a problem, late in the summer, and were repaired. We are still trying to put PVC, in all areas, when they become inoperable. It is a long and slow process, but the least expensive.

We thank the Rye Driftwood Garden Club once again, for their expertise and doing a great job at the Post office building. Much appreciated.

And, I thank my daughter, Linda, for teaching me how to use our computer and keeping me on the straight and narrow. She is a tremendous help.

Also, to our board members and my fellow Commissioners, many thanks guys.

Be happy - Spring is in the air. And we must remember to look for the silver lining. Think daffodils!

Rye Beach Precint Board of Adjustment For year ending 31 December 2009

The Rye Beach Precinct Board of Adjustment met four (4) times to hear petitions and appeals.

1. <u>11 March 2009.</u> The Board reviewed request for variance by Abenaqui Country Club for property at 731 Central Road, to permit placement of 720 square foot, 3 Bedroom, 1 bath, modular housing unit to be used as housing facility for 8 seasonal interns to be placed adjacent to Abenaqui Maintenance facility.

Request for Variance was Denied.

- 2. **24 June 2009.** The Board reviewed request for Variance by Real Estate Investors Group, for property located at 930 Central Road for:
 - A. Expansion of Pool House by utilizing existing concrete and stone deck as foundation with no further encroachment or fill required.
 Request for Variance was Approved.
 - B. Addition to existing dwelling to be no closer to Right of Way than current status.

Request for Variance was Approved With Conditions.

3. **27 October 2009.** The Board reviewed petition for Appeal from an Administration Decision, by Langenberg Family Living Trust, and Clarice M. Casassa, that a Zoning Permit was erroneously granted to Virginia Irwin Revocable Trust to build a home upon Lot 22, Tax Map 1.

Petition for Appeal was Denied.

4. <u>16 December 2009.</u> The Board reviewed request for Variances by Real Estate Investors Group, for property located at 930 Central Road, to permit building additions to, and a second story upon, portions of an existing non-conforming dwelling, some proposed to be 14 feet from side line, where 25 feet is required and all located within wetlands buffer.

Hearing Continued to 4 January 2010 at request of Petitioner.

The Board meets, as requested, on the third (3rd) Wednesday of each month.

Applications and supporting materials shall be submitted at least twenty-one (21) days prior to hearing.

- Article 2: Joan Gittlein was nominated as District Clerk for the ensuing year by Chuck Tufts and seconded by Linda Shepard. She was elected by a majority vote.
- Article 3: Motion was made by Harold Moldoff to dispense of the reading and to accept the reports written from the Treasurer, Auditor, and Committees or Officers heretofore chosen and pass any votes relating thereto. Motion was M/S/P.
- Article 4: Betty Smith was nominated as Commissioner for a threeyear term by Brad Richard and seconded by Jerry Gittlein. She was elected by a majority vote.

Tyson Dines was nominated as Treasurer for the ensuing year by Chuck Tufts and seconded by Linda Shepard. He was elected by a majority vote.

Andrew Mahoney was nominated for Auditor for the ensuing year by Frank Drake and seconded by Harold Moldoff. He was elected by a majority vote.

- Article 5: A motion was made by Brad Richard and seconded by Jerry Gittlein to raise and appropriate such sums of money as may be necessary for the District charges for the ensuing year of \$126,600.00. Article 5 was adopted by a voice vote.
- Article 6: A motion was made by Frank Drake and seconded by Harold Moldoff to authorize the District Officers to raise

money by District note in anticipation of taxex. Motion was M/S/P.

Article 7: To see if the District would vote to authorize the Commissioners to apply for, receive and expend Federal and State grants which may become available during the course of the year, in accordance with RSA31:95-b, and also to accept and expend money from any other governmental unit or private source to be used for purposes for which the District may legally appropriate money. Motion was so moved by Jerry Gittlein and seconded by Chuck Tufts.

Article 8: A motion was called to transact such other business as may legally come before said meeting.

Brad Richard said he would like to especially thank Betty Smith and Frank Drake for the numerous hours of work put into maintaining Rye Beach Precinct work. He also encouraged members of the community to attend meetings because new ideas are always welcome. There needs to be more citizen involvement.

Joan Gittlein thought to make the community aware of the beautiful work Blythe and Dan Brown generously contributed to the district by rebuilding the sidewalk and re-grading the porting of South Road adjacent to his property.

There was discussion among attending residents as to the possibility of a vacancy created by the postal service moving from the current site at the precinct building. Betty Smith assured residents that our contract was safe for the next few years.

There being no further business Al Casassa adjourned the meeting at 7:55 p.m.
