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SELECTMEN'S REPORT

1988 was a year of highs and lows. One of the highs was that we were one of very few towns in New Hampshire whose tax rate went down. This will be a hard act to follow with the continued big increases in the cost of running the school district, in addition to normal maintenance and improvements on town roads and buildings.

Many of the building repairs and improvements are mandated by Concord out of the Fire Marshall's office, Insurance office or Safety Department. Others, like repairing the roof over the stage in the Town Hall, are out of necessity as it is leaking badly.

On the down side, dogs are not being licensed and restrained according to the law. We hope for much better enforcement in 1989, as from time to time, the town has to spend tax dollars for damage done by uncontrolled dogs. We have made some progress in cleaning up junk cars, but were slowed by lack of a way to dispense of them. This situation seems to be easing and we hope to again make progress.

In the fall, the Selectmen along with the Chairman of the Budget Committee, Planning Board and the Road Agent went over all the black top roads with a representative of Whitcomb's to formulate a ten year plan for road maintenance. This we hope will enable us to better plan for the future.

At the Community Hall, the Town Meeting was called to order, by the Moderator, Mr. Richard Cummings, at 7:00 P.M., on March 9th, to act upon the Warrant Articles.

ARTICLE 3

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$64,817.00 to defray Town Charges for the ensuing year.

ARTICLE 4

Voted, by voice, to raise and appropriate the total sum of \$83,650.00 for the maintenance of highways and bridges and construction of the same for the ensuing year as follows:

\$54,441.00 to be raised by taxes

\$29,209.00 to be designated from Highway Block Grant

ARTICLE 5

Voted, by voice vote, to authorize the Selectmen to close an account called Revenue Sharing Fund and appropriate the balance remaining in the Federal Revenue Fund, established under provisions of the State and Local Assistance Act of 1972, this amount being approximately \$250.00 to be used for highway maintenance.

ARTICLE 6

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3,275.00 for the operation of the Police Department and the purchase and maintenance of equipment of the Police Department.

ARTICLE 7

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,600.00 for the purchase of a Radar Unit for the Police Department.

ARTICLE 8

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3,475.00 for the operation of the Fire Department for fire protection and purchase and maintenance of Equipment and Buildings for the Fire Department.

ARTICLE 9

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3,804.00 to provide and maintain Public Library service and authorized the Library Trustees to receive and use supplemental funds as provided.

ARTICLE 10

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,500.00 for the care and maintenance of Town Cemeteries.

ARTICLE 11

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3,000.00 for deposit to the Capital Reserve for Major Highway Equipment Purchase.

ARTICLE 12

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000.00 for deposit to the Capital Reserve for Revaluation.

ARTICLE 13

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$500.00 for deposit to the Trust Fund for Forest Fire Fighting Liabilities or the purchase of Forest Fire Fighting Equipment.

ARTICLE 14

Amendment, reduce Article 14 by a \$1,000.00, Passed on a voice vote. Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000.00 and place this amount in the Insurance Trust Fund.

ARTICLE 15

Voted, by voice vote, to accept the following Cemetery Trust Fund:
Edward J. McCann and Eleene C. McCann \$400.00

ARTICLE 16

Voted, by voice vote, to establish a Capital Reserve Fund to be known as Major Equipment for the Fire Department, for the purpose of purchasing major equipment including major radio equipment, and to designate the Selectmen as agents of the Town authorized to make withdrawals of principal and interest from said Capital Reserve, upon recommendation of the Fire Chief, to carry out the purpose of which it was established.

ARTICLE 17

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000.00 and place this amount in Capital Reserve for Major Equipment for the Fire Department.

ARTICLE 18

Voted, by voice vote, to accept the gift of a 1969 Ford Van Rescue Vehicle from the Sullivan Rescue Squad.

ARTICLE 19

Voted, by voice vote, to allow the Sullivan Rescue Squad to sell a 1968 Cadillac Rescue Vehicle for a fair price to replace the funds spent by the volunteer rescue account, to purchase the new rescue vehicle.

ARTICLE 20

Voted, by voice vote, to establish a Sullivan Cemetery Study Committee to consist of Five (5) members. 1 member shall be a Selectman-designated by the Selectmen. 1 member shall be a Trustee of Trust Funds, Designated by the Trustees. 1 member shall be the Sexton of Cemeteries, and 2 members shall be from the community at large-designated by the Moderator; for the purpose of studying improvement and expansion of Town cemeteries. A report to Selectmen to be received from the Committee by December 31, 1988.

ARTICLE 21

Voted, by voice vote, that the Clerk cast one Ballot, to adopt the provisions or RSA 80:58-86 for a Real Estate Tax Lien Procedure.

ARTICLE 22

Voted, by voice vote, that the Clerk cast one Ballot, to authorize the Selectmen to adopt a Money Purchase Retirement Plan for employees of the Town and to execute a Resolution of Adoption with the ICMA Retirement Corporation.

ARTICLE 23

Amended - to delete the word mandatory, replacing it with voluntary newspaper recycling program by September 1, 1989, was defeated by a voice vote.

Amended - to insert after committee - Three (3) residents appointed by the Moderator - passed on a voice vote.

Voted, by voice vote, to Implement a voluntary newspaper recycling program by September 1, 1988, and Implement a mandatory newspaper recycling program by September 1, 1989, and Establish a standing Town Recycling Committee - three (3) residents appointed by the Moderator - to work with the regional solid waste management district toward further implementation of local recycling programs for additional materials.

ARTICLE 24

Voted, by voice vote, that the Clerk not cast no ballot for Article 24. Ballot vote - Yes in favor of Article as written.

Article 24 passed to make the Road Agent position a term of Two (2) years, as suggested by the Sullivan Highway Study Committee.

ARTICLE 25

Voted, by voice vote, to add three alternate members to the Planning Board as permitted by RSA 673:6 and to authorize the Selectmen to appoint one alternate for a term of two (2) years and two alternates for a term of three (3) years with all three alternates to have three year terms thereafter.

ARTICLE 26

Voted, by voice vote, to authorize the Selectmen to apply for, and to accept, on behalf of the Town, and to expend, any and all gifts, grants or other funds which may now or hereafter be forthcoming over and above the total appropriation of the Town.

ARTICLE 27

Voted, by voice vote, to authorize the Selectmen to sell and convey any Real Estate acquired by the Town during the period until next Town meeting and that the Selectmen be authorized to sell and convey such Real Estate by auction, sealed bid or in any other manner as justice may require.

ARTICLE 28

Voted, by voice vote, to authorize the Selectmen as Agents of the Town to borrow money in anticipation of Taxes.

ARTICLE 29

Voted, by voice vote, to accept the reports of the Agents, Auditor and Committees as printed in the Town Report.

ARTICLE 30

The Town Meeting extended a vote of "THANKS" to the Bicentennial Committee.

Money is left for landscaping the Town Hall grounds.

Alice Garrapy suggested that a new floor covering be gotten for the kitchen.

10. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,000 for Deposit to the Capital Reserve for Revaluation; or take any action relating thereto.
11. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$500 for Deposit to the Trust fund for Forest Fire Fighting Liabilities or the purchase of Forest Fire Fighting Equipment; or take any action relating thereto (not recommended by the Selectmen or Budget Committee).
12. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000 and place this amount in the Insurance Trust Fund; or take any action relating thereto.
13. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000 and place this amount in Capital Reserve for Major Equipment including Major Radio Equipment for the Fire Department; or take any relating thereto.
14. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,000 for the purpose of implementing a trash recycling program to be organized by the Recycling Committee or take any action relating thereto.
15. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of 4,294 to make repairs and improvements at the library as proposed by the Library Trustees or take any action relating thereto. (The Budget Committee has taken no action on this proposal).
16. To see if the Town will vote to deposit thirty percent (30%) of the revenues, a sum not to exceed \$5,000, collected pursuant to **RSA 79A** (the land use change tax) in a conservation fund in accordance with **RSA 79A:25 II**; or take any action relating thereto.

(By petition) To see if the Town will vote to instruct the Town's representatives to the General Court to respond to our solid waste crisis by taking all necessary measures to insure that New Hampshire adopt legislation that will permit consumers to return for refund of deposit within New Hampshire all soda, beer, wine cooler and liquor containers and that all unclaimed deposit monies shall be collected by the state and no less than eighty (80) percent shall be returned annually to local municipalities for the sole purpose of implementing, expanding and reimbursing community recycling projects.

(By Petition) To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to convey to the East Sullivan Cemetary Association a part of the property conveyed to the Town of Sullivan by Freda Hasting, 8 September 1976, Deed of Warranty Reg. Cheshire County Registry of Deeds, Volume 922, page 795, to be used as an annex to the East Sullivan Cemetery, or to take any action relating thereto.
19. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to apply for, and to accept, on behalf of the Town, and to expend, any and all gifts, grants or other funds which may now or hereafter be forthcoming over and above the total appropriation of the Town.

20. To see if the Town will vote to accept the reports of the Agents, Auditor and Committees as printed in the Town Report.

21. To transact any other business which may legally come before this meeting and to listen to opinions of a purely advisory nature in regard to the Conduct of Town Affairs for the ensuing year.

NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS

A new law effective April 1, 1978, imposes a penalty for failure to file a **fully completed** inventory form.

“RSA 74:7-a Penalty for Failure to File. Any person who fails to file a fully completed inventory form on or before April 15, unless granted an extension under RSA 74:8, shall pay a penalty of one percent of the property tax for which he is liable. In no case, however, shall the penalty be less than \$10 or more than \$50. Any person who fails to file an inventory form and who becomes liable to pay the penalty specified in this section shall lose his right to appeal any matter pertaining to the property tax for which he is liable or exemptions to which he may be entitled. This penalty has all the force of taxation and shall be treated as incident to the tax.”

Inventory blanks are mailed before March 23 as required under RSA 74:5, but if for any reason you fail to receive one, you should contact the Selectmen to obtain one and complete it as required above.

The Town of Sullivan still requires the use of inventory forms. Current Use, Veteran and Elderly Exemptions must be applied for annually on the reverse side of the inventory.

Newly formed committees began using the library this year in addition to our regular groups. New are **The Recycling Committee** and **The Friends of the Sullivan Library**. **Voter Registration** was also held in the library. **The Library Trustees, The Bi-monthly Blood Pressure Clinic, and The Planning Board** continued to meet here.

The Library Trustees sponsored 8 programs which appealed to a variety of audiences. In January, **Bicentennial Reminiscence Night** featured Becky Cummings' videotape and Roger Thayer's slides, and attracted over 50 people. Later, in October, Roger again treated us to slides of **Japan Today**. Another slide program was **Gathering the Maple Sap** watched by Mrs. King's class after Ted Parker showed them his maple syrup operation. Two fine craft programs were held this year: **Swedish Weaving** by Mary Parker and **Glass-Engraving** by Ann Claridge. Another time discussion centered around Ruth Pratt's **Founding a Library Friend's Organization**. Also, **Encouraging Small Businesses**, presented with the Planning Board, was given by Bob Panton. We ended the year on an upbeat tempo with Matt Burke's **Holiday Song Fest** when 30 people gathered to sing despite the snow.

The Trustees also backed the **Summer Reading Program** that 36 children joined. They hosted 2 parties: one honoring our student aides, the other celebrating the end of the reading program. Pat McMahon showed a film and Toadstool Bookstore provided awards.

ROAD AGENT'S REPORT

This year South Road was paved as well as parts of Cross and Boulder Roads. Part of South Road was chip sealed. Brush and roadside mowing was done in the summer of 1988. The dirt roads in town were graveled, but need more. Some have very little gravel left to grade.

The winter of 88-89 brought more ice than usual. This winter has put a big crunch on sand and salt. We used 600 to 700 yards of sand by January and have put up 400 yards more, to finish the winter.

Our paving company has been working on a ten year plan for our paved roads. We are moving forward with Special Projects, but much more needs to be done.
