SELECTMEN'S REPORT

In Nineteen Eighty Nine, more road repairs were made in accordance with our long range plan. Some repairs and improvements were made to town buildings, such as a new roof over the stage area of the town hall, along with some new wiring, outlets and emergency lights. At the library, the bathroom was made useable for all times of the year. Also added was a handicap ramp so anyone can now get into the library. At the fire station a roof was put over the side door and the door casing was repaired. A railing was put up to the balcony, per our Safety Loss Prevention Representative from the insurance company. In addition to this, we had an unplanned expense of having to replace the oil burner. With the donation of time and labor of some of the firemen, we were able to keep the cost at a minimum.

With the above type of cooperation and that of many more people, plus the state changing its formula in regard to funding of the schools; and some change in the land use change tax, we were again able to have a lower tax rate.

At the Community Hall, the Town Meeting was called to order, by the Moderator, Mr. Alfred Rubega, at 7:00 P.M., on March 15th, to act upon the Warrant Articles.

ARTICLE 3

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$69,546.00 to defray Town Charges for the ensuing year.

Voted, by voice, to raise and appropriate the total sum of \$94,472.00 for the maintenance of highways and bridges and construction of the same for the ensuing year as follows:

\$62,646.00 to be raised by taxes

\$31,826.00 to be designated from Highway Block Grant

ARTICLE 5

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3,325.00 for the operation of Police Department and purchase and maintenance of equipment of the police department.

ARTICLE 6

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$4,685.00 for the operation of the Fire Department for fire protection, purchase and maintenance of equipment and buildings of the fire department.

ARTICLE 7

Amendment to add \$200.00 was passed by voice vote.

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$4,044.00 to provide and maintain Public Library service and authorized the Library Trustees to receive supplemental funds as provided.

ARTICLE 8

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,500.00 for the care and maintenance of Town Cemeteries.

ARTICLE 9

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3,000.00 for Deposit to the Capital Reserve for Major Highway Equipment Purchase.

ARTICLE 10

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,000.00 for deposit to the Capital Reserve for Revaluation.

ARTICLE 11

Voted, by voice vote, to table Article 11, which was to see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$500.00 for deposit to the Trust Fund for Forest Fire Fighting liabilities or the purchase of Forest Fire Fighting Equipment.

ARTICLE 12

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000.00 and place this amount in the Insurance Trust Fund.

ARTICLE 13

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1000.00 and place this amount in Capital Reserve for Major Equipment including Major Radio Equipment for the Fire department.

ARTICLE 14

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,000.00 for the purpose of implementing a trash recycling program to be organized by the Recycling Committee.

ARTICLE 15

Amendment to increase to \$5,000.00 was defeated by voice vote.
Amendment to decrease to \$2,200.00 was passed on a voice vote.
Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,200.00 to make repairs and improvements at the library as proposed by the Library Trustees.

ARTICLE 16

Voted, by voice vote, to deposit thirty percent (30%) of the revenues, a sum not to exceed \$5,000.00, collected pursuant to RSA 79A (the land use change tax) in a conservation fund in accordance with RSA 36-a:5 11 as authorized by RSA 79-A:25 11.

ARTICLE 17

Voted, by voice vote, to instruct the Towns representatives to the General Court to respond to our solid waste crisis by taking all necessary measures to insure that New Hampshire adopt legislation that will permit consumers to return for refund of deposit within New Hampshire all soda, beer, wine cooler and liquor containers and that all unclaimed deposit monies shall be collected by the state and no less than eighty (80) percent shall be returned annually to local municipalities for the sole purpose of implementing , expanding and reimbursing community recycling projects.

ARTICLE 18

Voted, by voice vote, to table, which was to authorize the selectmen to convey to the East Sullivan Cemetary Association a part of the property conveyed to the Town of Sullivan by Freda Hastings, 8 September 1976, deed of Warranty Reg. Cheshire county Registry of deeds, vol. 922 page 795, to be used as an annex to the East Sullivan Cemetary.

ARTICLE 19

Voted, by voice vote, to authorize the selectmen to apply for, and to accept, on behalf of the town, and to expend, any and all gifts, grants or other funds which may now or hereafter be forthcoming over and above the total appropriation of the Town.

ARTICLE 20

Voted, by voice vote, to accept the reports of the Agents, Auditor and Committees as printed in the Town Report.

ARTICLE 21

March 16, 1989 a Dog Rabies Clinic to be held at the Recreation Center, Washington Street, Keene, between 3:00 - 8:00 P.M..

5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$50,000 for the reconstruction and resurfacing of bituminous surfaced roads or take any action relating thereto.
6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3,425 for the operation of the Police Department and the purchase and maintenance of equipment of the police department or take any action relating thereto.
7. To see if the town will raise and appropriate the sum of 3,475 for the operation of the Fire Department for fire protection, purchase and maintenance of equipment and buildings of the fire department or take any action relating thereto.
8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$5,943 to provide and maintain Public Library service and authorize the Library Trustees to receive and use supplemental funds as provided; or take any action relating thereto.
9. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,500 for the care and maintenance of Town Cemeteries; or take any action relating thereto.

10. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$4,000 for Deposit to the Capital Reserve for Major Highway Equipment Purchase; or take any action relating thereto.
11. To see if the town will vote to authorize the selectmen to withdraw an amount not to exceed \$10,000 from the Capital Reserve Fund for Highway Major Equipment Purchase for the purchase of a second hand road grader, with the approval of a committee to be named, should such a piece of equipment become available to or take any action relating thereto.
12. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3,000 for Deposit to the Capital Reserve for Revaluation or take any action relating thereto.
13. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000 and place this amount in the Insurance Trust Fund; or take any action relating thereto.
14. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000 and place this amount in Capital Reserve for Major Equipment including Major Radio Equipment for the Fire Department; or take any relating thereto.

SULLIVAN PLANNING BOARD REPORT

During the 1989, the Planning Board launched several projects including preliminary steps toward creating a capital improvements program and updating the master plan. A major task was finally completed with the adoption on December 6, 1989, of the new subdivision rules and regulations. The new regulations bring our town in line with the changes in State Law as well as clarifying a number of our practices. The most important change is that the regulations are organized by section. The sections detail in clear language the steps that must be taken in order to file a subdivision, what information must be provided to the Planning Board, and the grounds for approval or disapproval of a proposal.

Several members of the board attended the annual Municipal Law Lecture Series and one member attended a formal course in land use planning.

During the year ending December 31, 1989, the board was presented with four subdivision proposals. Two were approved, one was not approved, and one is pending as we enter 1990.

The Board's major goal for next year is to complete updating the Master Plan. With the passage of the Community Planning Ordinance in March of 1989 and the completion of the new Subdivision Regulations, the Board can turn its full attention to the vital task of a new Master Plan. Once that has been accomplished, we will have the basis for the capital improvements program.

SULLIVAN CEMETERY STUDY COMMITTEE

It was recommended that development begin in 1990 and be spread over several years in order to lessen the tax impact of developmental costs. The new lot area should be completed and available by the mid 1990's.

1989 LIBRARY REPORT

Statistics for 1989 are as follows:

- ★ New Library patrons — 44 Total Registered Patrons — 362
- ★ Number of patrons using the library — 2,033
- ★ Number of books circulated — 3,627
- ★ Fiction & Non-Fiction: **Adults** — 1,395 **Juvenile** — 1,882
- ★ Number of Inter-Library loan books — 48
- ★ New & Donated Books cataloged—131
- ★ Magazines discontinued — 2 (Profiles, Outdoor Life)
- ★ Added to reference section — **Simpson's Contemporary Quotations, Thorndike's Illustrated Children's Dictionary, History of Gilsum.**

Meetings were held by 8 organizations during the year: **The Library Trustees, Supervisors of the Checklist, Friends of The Library, Planning Board, Boy Scouts' Executive Board, The Conservation and Recycling Committees,** and a single meeting by the **Budget Committee.** We also continued to host **The Bi-monthly Blood-Pressure Clinic.**

Programs for both children and adults were sponsored by the Library Trustees. **History and Historical Preservation** were the theme in two programs: Dennis Noonan presented a video recreation of "**The Battle of Gettysburg**" and Alan Rumrill spoke on "**Town Archives.**" Two workshops on traditional crafts were held: Carol Hamlin, "**All About Quilts**" and Nadine Henry, trustee, "**Making a Cathedral Pillow.**" First-hand accounts spotlighted two other programs: Cyndi Lewis, author, told how she wrote her book, "**Mothers First Year**", and Alan Corindia recalled some eerie events on Mt. Washington that entertained an audience of Sullivan children at a Halloween program.

Joint efforts gave impetus to the state-issued "**Year of the Younger Reader.**" At the Trustees' Summer Reading Program Party, financed in part by Recreation funds, folksinger Purlly Gates performed and Papa Ginos and Toadstool Book Shop provided gift certificates. Friends of the Library initiated an **Easter Story-telling and Egg Hunt** and a **Pictures with Santa and Gift Table** to which Recreation funds also contributed. School children raised money for books during a "**Readathon Week**" organized by the Friends of the Library, and in November Cheryl Derosier and Sarah Burke began a **Preschool Story Time** on Tuesday mornings.

The Holiday Fair remains the Trustees' main fund raiser. Along with some donations from overdues and the selling of some donated books, four plastic children's chairs, a small rug, book labeling equipment, pamphlet organizers, and a brand-new copier were purchased for the library.

With town-approved funding the Trustees were able to have emergency lighting added, necessary improvements made to the bathroom heating system, and a ramp built for the handicapped. Funds are still needed, however, to provide secure and adequate storage for the library and various town organizations that will meet state fire insurance and safety requirements.

Your library is now open ten hours a week and we appreciate your support. Thank you.
