THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

L.S.

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Orange in the County of Grafton in said state, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town House in said Orange on Tuesday, the 10th day of March, next at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

ARTICLE 1. To choose by ballot and plurality vote: a Town Clerk, Town Treasurer, one Selectman for three years, a Tax Collector, a Road Agent, a Constable, one Trustee of Trust Funds for one year, one Library Trustee for three years, two Auditors, one Cemetery Agent, one Overseer of Public Welfare, Fence Viewers, Measurers of Wood, Bark and Lumber and all other officers that the Town may judge necessary.

ARTICLE 2. To raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,150 for the payment of Town Charges for the ensuing year.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$60 to pay Town House expenses.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$500 for the Summer maintenance of Highways and Bridges.

- **ARTICLE 5.** To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,800 for the Winter maintenance of Highways and Bridges.
- **ARTICLE 6.** To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$400 for the upkeep of the Town Truck.
- ARTICLE 7. To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$1.500 to repay a bank loan of similar amount.
- ARTICLE 8. To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$1500 to repair that four paid for interest on bank loans.
- **ARTICLE 9.** To see if the Town will raise and appropriate \$212.50 for Town Road Aid and the State will contribute \$1,416.66.
- **ARTICLE 10.** To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$40 for Insurance on the Town House.
- ARTICLE 11. To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$120 insurance on the Town Truck.
- ARTICLE 12. To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000 for Old Age Assistance.
- ARTICLE 13. To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$20 for the maintenance of the Town Library.
- ARTICLE 14. To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$60 for the maintenance of the Town Cemeteries.

ARTICLE 15. To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$5 for the decoration of Soldiers' graves on Memorial Day.

ARTICLE 16. To see if the Town will vote to hire the Canaan Fire Department for services in case of fires in Orange. And to raise and appropriate the sum of \$100 for this purpose. Said \$100 to be placed in the "Orange Fire Fund."

ARTICLE 17. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$100 for the Orange Auxiliary Fire Department. Said \$100 to be placed in the "Orange Fire Pump Fund."

ARTICLE 18. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to hire money in anticipation of taxes to pay necessary town charges.

ARTICLE 19. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen and Deeding Agent to administer or dispose of any real estate acquired through Tax Collector's Deeds in the town.

ARTICLE 20. To see if the Town will vote to give a discount on taxes paid in full, within fifteen days from the date of the tax bill.

ARTICLE 21. To hear the reports of agents, auditors and other officers heretofore chosen and pass any vote relating thereto.

ARTICLE 22. To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting not included in this Warrant.
