


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#### REPORT OF THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN

The past year has been a busy one. The Current Use Law required an examination of all Town land in current use in order to comply with the new classifications. Les Goodnow, retired Selectman, generously volunteered to take on the task and the Board extends its gratitude.

The revaluation of Town property was put into the hands of the Department of Revenue Administration (DRA). The fieldwork has been completed. We are now waiting for spring when the DRA will conduct the annual pick-ups and then the property owners will be informed of their new assessments. Hearings will be scheduled to give property owners a chance to air their concerns with the new assessments.

Selectman, Kelly Darby, generously donated and IBM Personal System/2 Model 30-286 CPU with an IBM Color Monitor, to the Town. We are now planning how to fully utilize this new system.

This year, special road project monies were used being quided by the long range plan put into place by a previous Board. Chip seal was applied to the South Rd and Apple Hill Rd. The Gilsum Rd. had both recycling and chip seal as well as paving a small section.

Permits issued during the year were as follows: Pistol Permits 19; Junkyard Permits 4; Sale of Firearms Permit 1; Building Permits 6; Campground Permit 1.

The new year is already shaping into a promising year as we work to impliment policies and procedures and to bring our accounting system into compliance with that set forth by the New Hampshire Government Finance Officers Association. The Office is now open Monday - Friday from noon to 3:00 PM. Please feel free to visit the Office with any concerns our questions you have, this is YOUR town.

#### MINUTES OF THE 1992 TOWN MEETING

The Moderator, Mr. Alfred Rubega, opened the polls at 11:00 A.M. of March 10th at the Community Hall to bring in the ballots, for the Town Officers for the ensuing year, ordinance regulating Cluster Housing and the provisions of RSA 72:43-b amd 43-c for expanded exemptions of real estate. The checklist was duly posted and used in the balloting. Total number of ballots cast were 184. The checklist contained 345 names.

Do you favor the ordinance regulating cluster housing in the Town of Sullivan as proposed by the Planning Board?

#### Article 3

Shall we adopt the provisions of RSA 72:43-b and 43-c for expanded exemptions on real estate which provide for a resident 65 years of age up to 75, a \$5,000.00 exemption; a resident 75 years of age up to 80, a \$10,000.00 exemption; a resident 80 years of age or older, a \$20,000.00 exemption, provided that the resident owns the real estate individually or jointly with another or his spouse with whom he has been living for at least 5 years as man and wife; said resident had a net income of less than \$7,000.00 or combined income with spouse of less than \$9,000.00; and owns assets of any kind, tangible or intangible, less bona fide encumbrances, not in excess of the value specified in RSA 72:43-c,lll; provided that the exemptions shall be based upon the assessed value of the real estate?"

#### Article 5

Motion to amend - decrease the amount to be raised by taxes by \$7100.00 was declared defeated by the Moderator, by voice vote.

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$75270.00 for maintenance of highways and bridges for the ensuring year as follows:

\$47,600.00 to be raised by taxes \$27,670.00 to be designated from Highway Block Grant.

#### Article 6

Moderator declared voice vote uncertain.

Moderator declared a show of hands still uncertain.

Moderator declared a standing vote - 31 for Article 6

19 against article 6 Article 6 declared passed to raise and appropriate the sum of \$50,000.00 for the reconstruction and resurfacing of bituminous surfaced roads.

#### Article 7

Voted by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$6,322.00 for the operation of the Police Department and the purchase and maintenance of equipment of the Police Department.

#### Article 8

Voted by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$4,721.00 for the operation of the Fire Department for fire protection, purchase and maintenance of equipment and buildings of the Fire Department.

#### Article 9

Voted by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$4895.00 to provide and maintain Public Library service and authorize the Library Trustees to receive and use supplemental funds as provided.

#### Article 10

Voted by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,600.00 for the care and maintenance of Town Cemeteries.

#### Article 11

Moderator declared voice vote uncertain. Moderator declared a show of hands in favor of Article 11, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3,000.00 for deposit to the Capital Reserve for Major Highway Equipment Purchase.

#### Article 12

Motion to pass over Article 12 failed on a voice vote. Voted, by voice vote, not to remove \$8,000.00 from the Capital Reserve Fund for Highway Major Equipment Purchase for the purchase of a truck for the Highway Department.

#### Article 13

Motion to amend - increase to \$8,000.00 was declared defeated by voice vote.

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$4,000.00 for deposit to the capital reserve for Revaluation.

#### Article 14

Voted by voice vote, to pass over Article 14 - To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$500.00 and place this amount in the Capital Reserve for Major Equipment including Major Radio Equipment for the Fire Department.

#### Article 15

Voted, by voice vote, to accept provisions of RSA 76:15a to collect taxes by billing one-half based on the previous year's tax rate on June 15th and the remainder due and payable December 1st. This change to take effect with taxes assessed as of April 1, 1993.

#### Article 16

Voted by ballot - 57 to accept

10 not to accept to accept provisions of RSA 72:28, V and V1 for the optional veterans' tax credit and an expanded qualifying war service for veterans seeking the tax credit. The optional veterans' tax credit is \$100.00, rather than \$50.00.

#### Article 17

Voted, by voice vote, to defeat article 17 - to combine the positions of Road Agent and Sexton into a single position effective following Town Meeting, March, 1993

#### Article 18

Voted, by voice vote, to make the Road Agent's position a term of two years.

#### Article 19

Voted, by voice vote, to rescind the action taken in Article 17 in 1985 that designated Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and New Years Day as Town holidays allowing compensation of hourly paid employees at double an employee's normal rate for the first eight hours worked on said holidays and to authorize the Selectmen to negotiate a holiday pay policy with the Town Employees.

#### Article 20

Voted by voice vote, to accept the following Cemetery Trust Fund:

#### Article 21

Voted by voice vote, to authorize the Selectmen to apply for and to accept on behalf of the Town and to expend any and all gifts, grants or other funds which may now or hereafter be forthcoming over and above the total appropriations of the Town.

#### Article 22

Voted by voice vote, to authorize the Selectmen to sell and convey any Real Estate acquired by the Town during the period and convey such Real Estate by auction, sealed bid, or in any other manner as justice may require.

#### Article 23

Voted, by voice vote, to authorize the Selectmen as Agents of the Town to borrow money in anticipation of taxes.

#### Article 24

Voted, by voice vote, to authorize the Planning Board to prepare and amend a recommended program of Municipal Capital Improvement under RSA 674:5: "In a municipality where the Planning Board has adopted a master plan, the local legislative body may authorize the Planning Board to prepare and amend a recommended program of municipal capital improvement projects projected over a period of at least 6 years. The capital improvements program may encompass major projects being currently undertaken or future projects to be undertaken with federal, state, county and other public funds. The sole purpose and effect of the capital improvements program shall be to aid the mayor and the budget committee in their consideration of the annual budget."

#### Article 25

Voted, by voice vote, to accept the reports of the Agents, Auditor and Committees as printed in the Town Report.

#### Article 26

Discussion on whether to repair or replace the road grader.

The question as asked, "is there a better way to distribute the Town Reports?"

Suggestion of increasing the Board of Selectmen to five.

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers and School District Officials for the ensuing year.

You are hereby notified to meet at the Sullivan Town Hall on Wednesday the tenth (10th) day of March next at 7:00 P.M. of the clock in the evening to act on the following subjects:

- 2. To vote to raise the sum of \$75,750 to defray Town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same.
- 3. To vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$81,050 for the maintenance of highways and bridges for the ensuing year as follows:

\$53,122 to be raised by taxes \$27,928 to be designated from a Highway Block Grant

or to take any action relating thereto.

- 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$40,000 for the reconstruction and resurfacing of bituminous surfaced roads or take any action relating thereto.
- 5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$8,520 for the operation of the Police Department and the purchase and maintenance of equipment of the Police Department or take any action relating thereto.
- 6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$7,030 for the operation of the Fire Department for fire protection, purchase and maintenance of equipment and buildings of the Fire Department or take any action relating thereto.
- 7. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,800 for the purchase of protective clothing for the Fire Department or take any action relating thereto.
- 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$5,000 to provide and maintain Public Library Service and authorize the Library Trustees to receive and use supplemental funds as provided or take any action relating thereto.
- 9. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,000 for the care and maintenance of Town Cemeteries or take any action relating thereto.
- 10. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3,000 for deposit to the Capital Reserve for major highway equipment purchase or take any action relating thereto.
- 11. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$4,000 for deposit to the Capital Reserve for revaluation or take any action relating thereto.

- 12. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$5,000 for deposit to the Capital Reserve for major equipment including major radio equipment for the Fire Department or take any action relating thereto.
- 13. To see if the Town will vote to establish a Capital Reserve for major repairs of town buildings and to raise and and appropriate \$2,000 for deposit to it and to designate the Selectmen as agents of the Town authorized to make withdrawals from said fund, or to take any action relating thereto.
- 14. To see if the Town will vote to designate the Selectmen as agents of the Town authorized to make withdrawals from the Capital reserve for major highway equipment or take any action relating thereto.
- 15. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to apply for, and to accept on behalf of the Town and to expend any and all gifts, grants or other funds which may now or hereafter be forthcoming, over and above the total appropriation of the town.
- 16. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to sell any real estate acquired by the Town during the period until next Town Meeting and that the Selectmen be authorized to sell and convey such real estate by auction, sealed bid or in any other manner as justice may require.
- 17. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen as agents of the Town to borrow money in anticipation of taxes.
- 18. To see if the Town will vote by ballot to dissolve the Ashuelot Valley Refuse Disposal District organized under RSA Chapter 53-B (the "District"), pursuant to the provisions of Article VI, Section 7 of the district agreement for the District and the provisions of the plan of dissolution approved by the district committee of the District, a copy of which plan of dissolution has been submitted by the District to the Town.

A 2/3rds majority vote is required to approve this article.

#### 1992 CONSERVATION COMMISSION REPORT For the Town of Sullivan, New Hampshire

The Sullivan Conservation Commission met on a monthly basis and conducted the duties required of it per RSA 36:A. The six-member commission, including Rick Van de Poll, current Chair, Becky Cummings, Secretary, Matthew Burke, Selectman's representative (until October), Ed McCann, Planning Board representative, Joe Ovsenik, and Jean Hoffman, was joined by a seventh member, Dr. David Hall, in July. Business conducted included the town support of the nomination of the Ashuelot River under the NH Rivers Protection Program, attendance at regional and annual meetings of the NH association of Conservation Commissions, regular communication with state agencies requesting municipal natural resource information, and regular review of state wetland permit applications.

The relatively slow year regarding development allowed us to engage in the following special activites: 1) printing, sale and distribution of town-wide base, topo and soils maps\*; 2) inventory of town trails to support the NH trails advisory committee in their work to secure ISTEA funding; and 3) support and coordination of the clean-up of the town park and the installation of new playground facilities there. The latter was largely effected by the hard work of Al Henry and eagle scout candidate, Jason Briggaman. Many thanks Al and Jason, their scout helpers, Frank Philbrick and Matt Burke for the volunteer labor and materials tht helped upgrade our town play area. Many families have already

benefitted from this great improvement.

The conservation commission also sponsored regular hikes that were advertised in the newsletter. Like the meetings on the second Tuesday on the month, these hikes are free and open to the public. Anyone who has an interest in discovering some of Sullivan's conservation resources are welcome to attend.

#### SULLIVAN PLANNING BOARD REPORT

During 1992, the Planning Board concentrated on some procedural rules. We developed a subdivision checklist which will enable us to quickly review a subdivision proposal for any omissions or errors. We also adopted a set of bylaws to govern the conduct of our meetings. Finally, we have put together a Capital Improvements Program incorporating the funds now called Capital Reserve Funds.

The Board reviewed and approved three driveway permits and approved 2 boundary line adjustments. One subdivision proposal was reviewed and approved. One previously approved conditional subdivision was revoked. The Board also received numerous inquiries on whether or not changes in buildings or property use required Board approval as well as the usual number of inquiries from property owners regarding subdivision procedures.

A number of Board members attended the annual law lecture series. This year's topics included roads, conduct of public meetings, and zoning.

#### ASHUELOT VALLEY REFUSE DISPOSAL DISTRICT (53-B)

#### Plan of dissolution

The Ashuelot Valley Refuse Disposal District voted in the District Committee on December 8, 1992 to place on the ballot of member towns the question "Are you in favor of the dissolution of the 53-B District (the "Ashuelot Valley Refuse Disposal District")?" A 2/3 majority of voters present and voting in a town shall be required in order to affirm dissolution according to the District Agreement.

#### Date of Dissolution

 $\,$  The District will be automatically dissolved upon the date of filing a sworn affidavit with the Secretary of State.

The following provisions are made in accordance with Article VI, Section 7B of the District Agreement, "Plan of Dissolution";

- 1. The assets of the District are fully described and valued in the attached financial statement, which shall be considered part of the Plan of Dissolution.
- 2. The District has no known creditors or long-term obligations.
- 3. Assets of the District shall be distributed to current member municipalities by the percentage proportions shown on the attached statement, based on the 1990 census. The initial distribution shall be made as soon as possible after the date of dissolution, but shall not include the amount of \$27,500 approved as operating expenses for 1993-1996.
- 4. It is expected that the assets of the District will be adequate to discharge all obligations and tht no additional payments will need to be made by current member municipalities.
- 5. There are no remaining liabilities or obligations to be assumed by current member municipalities.
- 6. Any amounts remaining 3 years after the date of dissolution, including unexpended reserve funds from the operating budget and any amounts collected in claims against former members by said date or therafter, shall be distributed by the same method as described in (3) above. No amounts shall be reserved from distribution more than 3 years after the date of dissolution, except to the limited extent necessary to complete outstanding legal proceedings or other statutory legal requirements, if any.

For a period of 3 years after the date of dissolution, the District shall continue as a body corporate for the sole purpose of settling its financial affairs, and shall be authorized to elect officials and conduct meetings according to the District Agreement, except to the limited extent necessary to complete outstanding legal proceedings or other statutory legal requirements, if any.

The big news for 1992 is the acquisition of a computer system. With the help of a NH technology Matching-Funds Grant and the fundraising of the Friends of the Library, we were able to buy a computer with a CD-ROM drive, a modem for telecommunications, and a printer. Use of the system has already begun to increase. Once we are online with the NH State Library Sysytem, we will be able to do inter-library loans and have access to thousands of books and materials. The CD-ROM application includes an encyclopedia and business statistics disks along with reference books - like dictionaries and a thesaurus.

Diane Henry had to resign from her assistant library position due to time constraints in her job. She has been a vital force in the Sullivan Library program and has agreed to help out with the computer whenever she can. Seth Cummings has taken over as assistant.

The physical layout of the library has changed to accomodate the new computer and create a more accessible children's books area. The Friends spent most of the summer carting books from the shelves and then returning them after the walls had been painted by David McKenna. Alan Henry helped with the restructuring and is at this time installing special piping for a frost-free bathroom.

The Friends sponsored a Christmas Bazaar, a Santa's Workshop, an Easter egg hunt and various other helpful community projects. Due to the interior re-desing and the mess it caused, the summer children's reading program was not as well attended as in previous years. However, this years program will be back to the usual high attendance and fun.

The Library has once again become active in the Nubanusit Area Library Co-op, and one of the immediate benefits is a video exchange program. We will also be starting our own collection of videos soon.

Besides being the source of books and information for the town, the Library is used as the meeting place for the PLanning Board, the Conservation Committee, the Supervisors of the Checklist for voter registration, and the Health Department for Blood Pressure Clinics.


