TOWN WARRANT

To the inhabitants of the Town of Windsor in the County of Hillsborough in said State, qualified to vote in Town affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town House in said Windsor on Tuesday, the 13th day of March, next at six of the P. M. clock to act on the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray Town charges for the ensuing year and to make appropriations of the same.
3. To hear the reports of Auditors and Agents heretofore chosen and to pass any vote in relation thereto.
4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate such sums of money as may be necessary for repairing highways and bridges.
5. To see if the Town will vote to accept State Aid on its highways and raise and appropriate \$19.52 as the Town's share.
6. To see if the Town will vote and appropriate \$200 at the rate of \$50 for the next four years for white pine blister rust.
7. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate \$250 for the upkeep of the Town House.
8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate \$30 for street lighting.
9. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen (Treasurer) to borrow money in anticipation of taxes.
10. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate \$200 to be applied to the Capital Reserve Fund for future Bridge Construction.
11. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate \$100 for the upkeep of the Town Cemetery.
12. To see if the Town would rather have the State Tax Commission audit the Town's books each year, than have a Town auditor and to have the expense for same to be spent from Town Officers expenses.

13. To see what the Town will vote to raise for the future maintenance of the Town's highways.

14. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.

7. To choose Agents, Auditors, and Committees in relation to any subject embraced in this warrant.
8. To see what sum of money the district will raise and appropriate for the support of schools, for the salaries of school district officials and agents, and for the payment of statutory obligations of the district, and to authorize the application against said appropriation of such sums as are estimated to be received from the State Foundation Aid together with other income; the School Board to certify to the Selectmen the balance between the estimated revenue and the appropriation, which balance is to be raised by taxes by the town.
9. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

To the School Board and Citizens of Windsor:

Following is my eighth annual report for your consideration:

The enrollment of school pupils from Windsor is the smallest in years. There are five elementary pupils and one high school pupil. Inasmuch as none will graduate and our census indicates that there will be no first graders next year, the number will remain the same for 1962-63 unless school age people move into the community.

The Financial Report for 1960-61 indicated that the cash on hand at the end of the school year was \$28.82. It also indicated that the School District owed the Hillsboro-Deering Cooperative School District \$1,720.00 for tuition and transportation, while the town of Windsor owed the Windsor School District \$2,142.66. The above problems have been worked out and it is expected that the report for next year will be more meaningful.

The 1961 Legislature has appropriated \$30,000 for an interim study of "School District Reorganization." Citizens of Windsor may wish to watch the work of this Committee very carefully, as their report may contain some recommendations that will be pertinent to the future operation of the Windsor School District.
