THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Chatham in the County of Carroll in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Chatham, on Tuesday, the eleventh day of March, next at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

- 1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing and vote their compensations.
- 2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same.
- 3. To see if the Town will vote to allow a 2% discount on all property taxes paid inside thirty days from receipt of tax bills.
- 4. To see if 'the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to donate \$200 of the Fire Department appropriation to the Saco Valley Fireman's Association.
- 5. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate the sum of \$21.93 asked for by the White Mountain Region Association.
- 6. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate \$25.00 for Civil Defense.
- 7. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate the \$1800 contained in the Budget under Town Construction to match \$4200 from the State to reconstruct bridge number 180/120 over McDonough Brook on the so-called Everett Eastman Road, by cementing the abutements and installing steel girders.

- 8. To see what action the Town will take upon the Budget as submitted by the Budget Committee.
- 9. To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.

REPORT OF FOREST FIRE WARDENS

Everyone apparently fears fire but too many are careless with it. This is particularly true of fires in or near woodland. Official figures show that more than 98% of all forest fires result from human carelessness and can be prevented. Consequently we may say "Forest Fires are our most shameful waste."

Annual forest fire losses are tremendous and their effects are far reaching. Such fires destroy the raw products of the forest, the protection forest provides for game, and the supply of ground water. They upset the local economies by drawing men from gainful employment and requiring the expenditure of public funds to extinguish them.

Your local warden and his deputies are doing an excellent job in trying to prevent this shameful waste, but they must have the cooperation of the public and this means YOU. Remember there are laws that cover the making of a camp fire, also the burning of rubbish or debris, and also the burning of brush whether this is on your land or land of other people, and to disobey these laws can cost you a great deal of money. So please see your local warden and he will tell you how to burn the rubbish, also when you can burn it, and also issue you a permit to do so if conditions are right.

In the "Keep America Green" program there is a story of two bad boys who cause most of our forest fires. The first one we will call "I don't care" - he is the person that builds a fire anywhere, never gets a permit to bu'n brush, or has a safe place for his home incinerator. He also is careless with matches and cigarettes. The other one is called "I don't know any better" and the best way to describe him is he is a plain dunce. It is only with your help that these two bad actors are controlled. Their carelessness can be the cause of our valuable woodland being destroyed by fire. Even your homes can be burned by their carelessness.

It is up to you and you to report these two characters to your local forest warden whenever you see them operating. Remember it is with your cooperation that this shameful waste of timber and money can be stopped.
