Warrant For Town Meeting

TOWN OF HART'S LOCATION

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the inhabitants of the Town of Hart's Location in the County of Carroll in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at Willey House Post Office in said Hart's Location on Tuesday, the 9th day of March next, at nine o'clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of same.
3. To authorize the Selectmen to borrow sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of same.
4. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$6.34 (amount being seven cents per thousand dollars of equalized valuation) for the White Mountain Region Association.
5. To see if the town will vote to petition the State Tax Commission to have an audit made by the Municipal Accounting Division and make appropriation to cover the expense of same.
6. To see if the Town will vote to raise Town Road Aid, \$16.84 to be used with State Highway Department quota of \$112.28 for all town roads.

7. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for all town roads.

8. To see if the Town will vote to have all unexpended funds revert to the General Fund.

9. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate money for School Tax, approximately \$160.00, amount being set by the State Tax Commission.

10. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$100.00 for the support of the Eastern Slope Regional Airport for the current year.

11. To act upon any other business that may legally come before said meeting.

School Report

Noschools are maintained by the town. The school tax is raised at the rate of \$1.50 per thousand rateable estate at the present time. Due to an amendment in the law in the last legislature, the school districts of some of the smaller towns, including Hart's Location were abolished. The State Tax Commission is now responsible for collecting the school tax, and annually assesses against the real and personal estate, an amount equal to the sum certified to it by the department of education. The Town of Hart's Location will vote each year on payment of the school tax by the town, as long as funds will allow. This money goes into the State Equilaization Fund, and is used for any education necessary.
