2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same.

4. To see if the Town will vote to qualify for T. R. A. and raise and appropriate the necessary amount for same.

5. To determine and appoint the salaries of the Town Officers and make appropriations for same.

6. To see if the Town will vote to have inventory blanks distributed at the time of taking inventory.

7. To see if the Town will vote to put culvert in on the Ira Downing road.

8. To see if the Town will vote to support the White Mt. Region Association and raise and appropriate money for same.

9. To see how much money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate to complete Town House repairs.
