Warrant For Town Meeting

TOWN OF HART'S LOCATION

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the inhabitants of the Town of Hart's Location in the County of Carroll in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at Willey House Post Office in said Hart's Location on Tuesday, the 10th day of March next, at nine o'clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of same.
3. To authorize the Selectmen to borrow sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of same.
4. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of 16.64 (amount being seven cents per thousand dollars of equalized valuation) for the White Mountain Region Association.
5. To see if the town will vote to petition the State Tax Commission to have an audit made by the Municipal Accounting Division and make appropriation to cover the expense of same.
6. To see if the Town will vote to raise Town Road Aid, \$23.78 to be used with State Highway Department quota of \$158.54 for all town roads, and make appropriation of same.

7. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$200.00 for all town roads.

8. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate \$300.00 for fire expenses.

9. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate \$208.00 for privilege of rubbish disposal at the Bartlett dump.

10. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate up to \$100.00 for ambulance service.

11. To see if the town will vote to elect their officers for a term of three years, per Chapter 243 of the Public Laws of N.H. passed in 1967. Town Clerk RSA 41-16A - Tax Collector RSA 41-2a - Treasurer RSA 41-26a.

12. To act upon any other business that may legally come before said meeting.
