

TOWN WARRANT

To the inhabitants of the Town of Conway, County of Carroll, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Conway Elementary School Auditorium at Conway, New Hampshire, March 11, 1969, at nine o'clock in the forenoon to act upon the following subjects:

Article 1. To choose all necessary officers.

Article 2. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for the following purposes:

Section a Town officers' salaries

b Town officers' expenses

c Office expenses

d Election and registration expenses

e District Court expenses

f Expenses town hall and other town buildings

g Appraisal of property

h Employees' retirement and social security

i Police department i Fire department

k Blister rust and care of trees

1 Insurance

m Damages and legal expenses

n Civil defense

o Health department, including hospitals

p Vital statistics q Town dump

q Town dump r Maintenance of highways – summer and winter

s Town road aid

t Libraries

u Town poor

v Old age assistance

w Memorial Day

x Soldiers' aid

y Parks and playgrounds

z Interest on temporary loans and bonds

a-1 Class IV Urban

b-1 New equipment

c-1 Bonds

d-1 Perambulation of town lines

e-1 Capital reserve for survey of streets and tax map

f-1 Tax map maintenance

g-1 County tax

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to hire upon the credit of the town such sums of money as may be needed, such sums not to exceed the combined School, Town and

County tax budget, in anticipation of taxes raised for Town, County

and School purposes.

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to subsidize ambulance service in the Town of Conway, the Town having been notified that the two local private ambulance services will no longer operate after April 1, 1969. And to see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate Twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) to subsidize such services for one year. Recommended by Budget Committee.

Article 5. To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,000 to be evenly divided between the Chambers of Commerce in Conway and North Conway, for the operation of information booths in both villages. Recommended by Budget Committee.

Article 6. To see if the Town will vote to change the term of office for the Town Clerk and Tax Collector from one year to three years. This was approved by the 1967 Legislature. Agreeable to a petition signed by Ervin S. Farrington and others. Recommended by Budget Committee.

Article 7. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000 (one thousand dollars) to help defray the expenses of the Water Safety Program as carried on by the Conway Chapter of the American Red Cross, Agreeable to a petition signed by Shumway Marshall and others. Recommended by Budget Committee.

Article 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,600 to help defray the expenses of the Home Health Agency of the Memorial Hospital, in order to continue and expand home nursing care for the people of Conway. Agreeable to a petition signed by Zaven K. Vorperian and others. Recommended by Budget Committee.

Article 9. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,900 to assist the Carroll County Mental Health Services, Inc. Agreeable to a petition signed by Francis Deasy and others. Recommended by Budget Committee.

Article 10. To see if the Town will vote to act upon the warrant of the Conway School District on the same day as the Town Meeting, and immediately following the close of Town Meeting.

Article 11. To act upon any other business that may legally

come before said meeting.

Report of Forest Fire Warden and District Chief

We are proud to report that during 1968 Eaton had a perfect record in that there were no forest fires here. We all wish this to continue in 1969.

People — and rarely, lightning — cause fires. The state records show that the number of fires increase in an area as the population increases. We in Eaton must all be aware of fire causes and work to prevent their occurrence.

The following action will help:

- 1. Teach our children the danger of lighted matches.
- 2. Never discard lighted smoking material from a car or while walking through fields or woods.
- 3. Safely dispose of rubbish, preferably at the town dump. If you must burn
 - a. You need a written permit from the town fire warden for *all* burning of debris and dead grass except when the ground is covered with snow. Cooking fires in outdoor fireplaces or in charcoal braziers in your own yard is permitted on notification to the warden.
 - b. The warden is forbidden by regulation to allow burning of household rubbish on grass and leaves by householders between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m.
 - c. Have equipment on hand to control the fire before you light it.
- 4. Promptly report any fire out of control to your fire warden, his deputies, any selectmen, or the fire department chief.

Help to keep our town out of the fire occurrence column and save your tax dollars for useful purposes.

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

February 13, 1969

Submitted herewith is the report of an examination and audit of the accounts of the Town of Conway for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1968 which was made by this Division in accordance with the vote of the Town. Exhibits as hereafter listed are included as part of the report.

One of the enclosed audits must be given the Town Clerk as part of the permanent records.

SCOPE OF AUDIT

Included in the examination and audit were the accounts and records of the Board of Selectmen, Treasurer, Tax Collector, Town Clerk, District Court, Library, Trustees of Trust Funds and Highway Bond Fund.

FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

Comparative Balance Sheets – December 31, 1967-December 31, 1968: (Exhibit A-1)

Comparative Balance Sheets as of December 31, 1967 and December 31, 1968, are presented in Exhibit A-1. As indicated therein, the surplus increased from \$15,449.39 to \$23,947.11 during 1968.

Analysis of Change in Financial Condition: (Exhibit A-2)

An analysis of the change in financial condition during the year is made in Exhibit A-2, with the factors which caused the change indicated therein.

Comparative Statements of Appropriations and Expenditures – Estimated and Actual Revenues: (Exhibits A-3 and A-4)

Comparative statements of appropriations and expenditures, estimated and actual revenues for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1968, are presented in Exhibits A-3 and A-4. As indicated by the budget summary (Exhibit A-4), a net unexpended balance of appropriations of \$16,646.24, plus a revenue surplus of \$30,535.53, resulted in a net budget surplus of \$47,181.77.

Summary Statement of Receipts and Expenditures: (Exhibit B-1)

A summary statement of receipts and expenditures for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1968, made up in accordance with the uniform classification of accounts, is included in Exhibit B-1. Proof of the Treasurer's balance as of December 31, 1968, is indicated in Exhibit B-2.

District Court: (Exhibit E)

A statement of the accounts of the District Court for the fiscal year is presented in Exhibit E.

Library: (Exhibit F)

A statement of the activities in the Library Account is presented in Exhibit F.

Highway Bond Fund: (Exhibit G)

The activity in this account consisted of interest income only.

Statement of Bonded Indebtedness: (Exhibit I)

A statement of outstanding bonded indebtedness as of December 31, 1968, showing annual debt service requirements, is contained in Exhibit I.

AUDIT PROCEDURE

The accounts and records of all town officials charged with the custody, receipts and disbursement of all public funds were examined and audited. Vouchers and cancelled checks were compared with supporting invoices and payrolls as well as entries in the books of record. Receipts were checked by source insofar as possible and totals of receipts and expenditures verified. Book Balances were verified by comparison with reconciled bank balances made from statements obtained from depository banks. Verification of uncollected taxes was made by mailing notices to delinquent taxpayers as indicated by the Collector's records. The amounts of uncollected and unredeemed taxes as indicated in this report are therefore subject to any changes which may be necessitated by the return of verification notices.

Current Surplus:

The current surplus (excess of total assets over current liabilities) decreased by \$1,502.28, from \$120.449.39 to \$118,947.11 in 1968, as shown herewith:

Tax Collector:

All receipts from taxes should be dated as of the actual day the money is received, entered in the cash book and posted to the warrant using the same date.

Added taxes should be recorded in the back section of each warrant for the year of levy of which the added tax applies.

All tax sales should be entered in the record of tax sales. In addition to the owners' name and description of the property, the following should also be recorded.

Unpaid tax Interest Cost Fees

These four columns should be added and shown in the price sold column. All columns should then be totaled and cross added to a grand total which should agree with the taxes bought by Town.

North Conway Water Precinct

It is noted that unredeemed taxes date back to 1960. It is recommended that after two years from date of tax sale a Tax Collector's deed should be given to the Town for all unredeemed taxes.

Conclusion:

The provisions of Chapter 184, of the Laws of 1955, require that this report or the summary of findings and recommendations (letter of transmittal) shall be published in the next annual report of the Town.

We extend our thanks to the officials of the Town of Conway for their assistance during the course of the audit.
