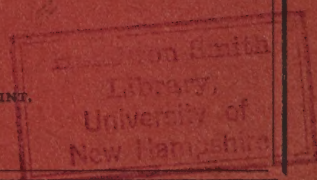
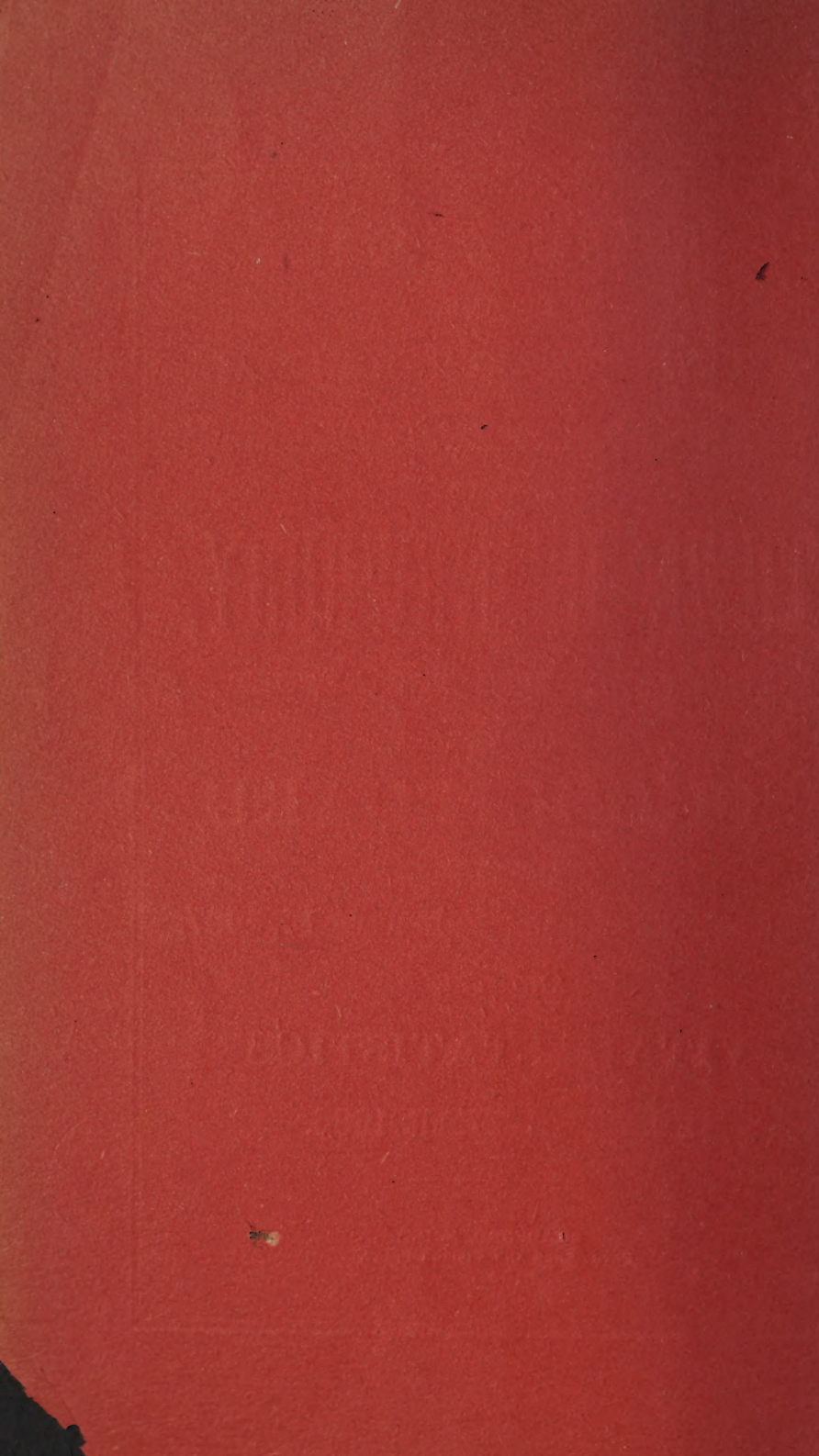

REPORT OF THE SCHOOL BOARD OF NEWBURY,

For the year ending Feb. 15, 1907.

The School Board of the school district of Newbury, respectfully submit the following Report.

In reviewing the past year we find that the Truant Officer reported the number of children between the ages of five and sixteen years, by the enumeration of September 1906, were eighty-four, an increase of ten, above the preceeding year.

In the financial school year which is now closed, we have endeavored to have twenty-six weeks of schooling in each of the six different schools maintained in the school district.

The supplies having been furnished each school for the year.

There are also supplies on hand at the present time to be used at the next term of school, and trust all pupils will remember that they are instructed with the care, and use of property that is not their own, and therefore use all town property loaned them in every way satisfactory to the town.

We think the schools, the past year have in every respect fully maintained their former reputation.

We were also glad to observe that while the teachers were laboring faithfully for the welfare of these pupils on the thoughts of education that they have not neglected to impart moral instruction. The greater part of a teacher's life is spent for the improvement of the pupils, and perhaps no duty of a teacher is more important than to try and instill into the minds of their pupils correct principles as regards right and wrong, learning each in their turn that the love of justice does not belong solely to any one class but is common to all.

To the teachers of the several schools, the School Board desire to tender their hearty thanks, and also here-by to express their high appreciation to the citizens of the School district, for all acts of kindness received from them, in the past year, in promoting the progress of education.
