To the Inhabitants of Dalton, qualified to vote in Town ... Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Dalton on Tuesday, the 14th day of March next, at ten o'clock in the forenoon to act upon the following subjects. The polls will be open at 12 o'clock.

- 1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the ensuing year.
- 2. To see if the Town will vote to give the Selectmen the right to issue temporary loans in anticipation of taxes.
- 3. To see if the Town will accept the Budget for 1967 as prepared by the Selectmen and appropriate the amounts therein or to make any changes.
- 4. To see if the Town will vote to replace the International truck with a new one and authorize the Selectmen to borrow on the credit of the Town a sum of money to pay for the same.
- 5. To see if the Town will vote a sum of money not to exceed \$567.00, the same being one dollar for each resident of the Town as of the last census, to aid in the support of the White Mountain Community Services. This is the mental health Clinic serving this area, including the Town of Dalton.
- 6. To see if the Town will vote to establish a Planning Board of five members with duties as set forth in Sections 1-15, Chapter 35, N. H. Revised Statutes Annotated, 1955, to make a study of the Town's development and report to the Town appropriate recommendations for the promotion and maintenance of the Town's best development. The Board shall consist of one Selectman and four other citizens appointed by the Selectmen, as provided in Chapter 36, N. H. Revised Statutes Annotated, 1955. Also to raise a sum of money not to exceed \$100.00 for the expenses of this Board.
- 7. To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.

At the Well Child Conferences, 23 physical exams were given, and 37 immunizations.

Fifty-five individuals participated in the Heaf testing program for tuberculosis detection.

Five children have attended the Crippled Children's Clinics, and two children have attended the Pediatric Cardiology Clinics.
