

Warrant For Town Meeting

1973

Town of Hart's Location

State of New Hampshire

To the inhabitants of the Town of Hart's Location in the County of Carroll in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at Willey House Post Office in said Harts Location on Tuesday, the thirteenth day of March, next, at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

- l. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
- 2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of same, including town officers salaries, town officers expenses, election and registration expenses, fire department, damages and legal expenses, health department and ambulance service, dump and garbage removal, town maintenance of highways (summer), lighting, town road aid, and advertising and regional expenses.
- 3. To authorize the Selectmen to borrow sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of same.
- 4. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$20.16 (amount being seven cents per thousand dollars of equalized valuation) for the White Mountain Region Association.
- 5. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$20.37 Town Road Aid, to be used with State Highway Department quota of \$135.81 for all Town roads.
- 6. To see if the town will vote to petition the State Tax Commission to have an audit made by the Municipal Accounting Division and make appropriation to cover the expense of same.
- 7. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$100.00 for all town roads.
- 8. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate \$300.00 for fire expenses.
- 9. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate \$200.00 for dump and garbage removal.
- 10. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate \$36.16 for Health Department and Ambulance Service.
- 11. To see if the voters of Harts Location will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$100.00 for the purchase of a rescue litter.

- 12. To see if the Town will vote to establish a Planning Board of five (or seven) members with duties as set forth in Sections 1-15, Chap. 36 N. H. Revised Statues Annotated, 1955, to make a study of the Town's development and report to the Town appropriate recommendations for the promotion and maintenance of the Town's best development. The board shall consist of one Selectman and four (or six) other citizens appointed by the Selectmen, as provided in Chap. 36, N. H. Revised Statues Annotated, 1955.
- 13. To see if the Town will vote to authorize and empower the Town Planning Board to approve or disapprove in its discretion new subdivisions and plats thereof, showing streets, or the widening thereof, or parks. Upon the passage of this article, it shall be the duty of the Town Planning Board to prepare and adopt subdivision regulations as provided in Chapter 36: Sections 21 and 22, New Hampshire Revised Statues annotated, 1955. Upon the adoption of such subdivision regulations, it shall be the duty of the Town Clerk to file with the Register of Deeds of the County of Carroll a certificate or notice showing that the said Town Planning Board has been so authorized and has so adopted subdivision regulations, giving the dates of such authorization and adoption, as provided in Chapter 36: Sections 19-29 inclusive. If the article is adopted, it shall further be the duty of the Town Clerk to issue all certificates of failure when the Town Planning Board shall fail to take action as provided in Chapter 36: Sections 19-29 inclusive.
- 14. To see if the town of Harts Location will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$50.00 to cover cost of a plot map, and other planning expenses.
- 15. To act upon any other business that may legally come before said meeting.
