DURHAM, N.H. – Want to work outdoors this summer? Come to the University of New Hampshire's annual Outdoor Jobs and Camp Fair Thursday, Feb. 19, 2009, 11 a.m. – 3 p.m. in the Granite State Room of the Memorial Union Building at UNH.
