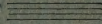

THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the inhabitants of the Town of Wentworth Location in the County of Coos in the said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the School House in said Town on Tuesday, the 14th day of March next, at nine of the clock in the forenoon to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations for the same.
3. To see if the Town will vote to accept State Aid for Highways and raise and appropriate the amount required by law to secure the same.
4. To see if the Town will vote to raise money for fire equipment.
5. To see if the Town will vote to authorize Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of Taxes.
6. To see if the town will vote to have driveways ploughed and raise money for the same.
7. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for Bonded Debt.
8. To see if the Town will vote to raise \$12.00 for White Mountain region.

9. To see if the Town will vote to let Magalloway and Wilson Mills hook on to electric light line.
10. To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.
