## WARRANT FOR THE ANNUAL TOWN MEETING

## THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

(L. S.)

*To the inhabitants of the Town of Webster, in the County of Merrimack, in said State, qualified to vote in town affairs:*

You are hereby notified to meet at Grange Hall in said Webster on Tuesday, the tenth day of March, next at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same.
3. To raise and appropriate such sums of money as may be necessary for the maintenance of highways and bridges.
  - a. Summer Maintenance
  - b. Winter Maintenance
  - c. Tar Roads
  - d. General Expense of Highway Department
  - e. Street Lighting
4. To raise and appropriate the sum of \$536.88 for Class V road construction.
5. To raise and appropriate such sums of money as may be necessary for public welfare.
  - a. Town Poor
  - b. Old Age Assistance
6. To raise and appropriate such sums of money as may be necessary for the support of the town library.



7. To raise and appropriate such sums of money as may be necessary for patriotic purposes.

- a. Old Home Day                      b. Memorial Day

8. To raise and appropriate such sums of money as may be necessary for the support and maintenance of the Hy-Mar Fire Department, including forest fires.

9. To see what sum the town will vote to raise and appropriate for the care of cemeteries.

10. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$400 for use in the connection with the state program for the eradication of White Pine Blister Rust.

11. To see if the town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$111 toward the operating deficit of the Concord Hospital, this amount being based on the number of patients admitted from Webster.

12. To authorize and empower the Board of Selectmen to borrow for the town, by the issuance of notes, a sum not exceeding \$20,000 in anticipation of taxes for the year 1959, said notes payable from said taxes within one year from the date of issuance, and to authorize the Board of Selectmen to determine the rate of interest on such notes and to provide for the sale thereof.

13. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$100 for the maintenance of the playground.

14. To see if the town will vote to raise \$25 to be expended in cooperation with the New Hampshire Forestry and Recreation Commission for the opening and maintaining of trails and old trails and old roads for forest fire protection. The New Hampshire Forestry and Recreation Commission to provide a matching sum not in excess of \$25 for this purpose.

15. To transact any other business that may legally come before the meeting.

The building committee proceeded with plans to build a three stall addition to the existing building.

Volunteer help cut logs on Town land and then hauled them to Robert Pearson's sawmill, who gave his time and equipment to saw these and other logs hauled in. James Roberts gave the use of his truck to haul logs and sawed lumber. All labor at the mill and use of machinery and trucks being donated by other local people.

Other volunteers, under the supervision of Mr. Lloyd H. Stone, gave their services to help erect a large portion of the building. Carpenters were hired to complete it, and the fire trucks were housed before cold weather.

Another valuable donation was an oil furnace, given by Mr. Charles Maynard. This was installed and has operated efficiently.

An estimate of total contributions of labor and material amount to \$1,500.00.

## PLAYGROUND PROJECT

---

During the past year the playground was very nearly completed. The University of New Hampshire was consulted in regards to the type of grass seed to be used and this was purchased according to their recommendation. A special fertilizer was also used.

Money was spent for the work which was done by machinery. However, all hand labor and some machine work being donated by the townspeople, also a majority of the loam.

The donations which were given were one of the big reasons for making this project a big success.

On behalf of the Town of Webster, the committees of both projects wish to sincerely thank Mr. Clarence E. Hyde, whose interest and generosity made the foregoing projects possible, and also our thanks to each and everyone who contributed to the success of the projects.

## YOU CAN HELP PREVENT FOREST FIRES

---

Twenty-five percent of all forest fires in New Hampshire are caused from careless debris burning—brush, paper, leaves, grass, etc. Most of them are started without the required permit from the local forest fire warden. The cost of extinguishing these fires annually runs into large sums of money.

According to law, responsible parties must pay the cost of putting them out. In addition, violators may be subject to court prosecution with fines running as high as (\$200) two-hundred dollars.

In the interest of fire prevention why not eliminate burning at home? Use your town dump. It has been set up for your personal convenience. It provides a suitable place for the disposal of dangerous inflammable waste material and other useless items which accumulate around the home and local stores; brush, etc. cut on your property. Eliminate the hazard of burning yourself. It will be easier for you—personally and financially.

If, however, you do burn on your premises:

1. Secure a permit from your local forest fire warden — the law requires it.
2. Be sure to properly supervise your burning. Don't leave it.
3. Make certain your fire is DEAD OUT before leaving it.

*Save yourself much possible difficulty.*

You are hereby notified to meet at the Grange Hall in said district on the 10th day of March 1959, at 1:00 o'clock in the afternoon to act upon the following subjects:

1. To elect the following School District Officers:

  - b. Clerk for the ensuing year.

For the second year we have the same teachers in the Webster Elementary School: namely Mrs. Ethel H. Colby and Mrs. Mabel M. Anderson, Principal. Both are experienced teachers and they work very well together.

Last year it looked as though we were going to have to cut down on the amount of time that Miss Bailey was able to spend on our music program in Webster. Fortunately the Hopkinton School Board was most cooperative and recognized the fact that Miss Bailey was carrying too heavy a load. Because they didn't want to deprive Webster and the other small towns in the Union of her services, they gave me permission to hire another part time music teacher to work in the Hopkinton Elementary Schools. This has been a big help in solving our music problem. Miss Bailey has more time at the High School to spend on instrumental work, which will be helpful to all the children in the long run.

Last spring more volunteer work was done on the playground. The grounds were covered with loam and then seeded down. Now the children have an excellent playground and baseball field. There aren't many schools in the state that have more attractive or better equipped playgrounds: all because of the generosity of many Webster people. "Webster certainly takes care of its own."

Our enrollment is showing a gradual increase. At the present time we have twenty-six pupils in Mrs. Anderson's room and thirty-three pupils in Mrs. Colby's or a total of fifty-nine pupils. At the present time there are a total of sixty-five pre-school pupils from the age of one through five. There will be five or six in the entering first grade next year and the following years will be 10, 12, 13, 11, and 12 respectively which indicates we could have rooms with over forty pupils, much too many for a teacher with grades in a room.

I believe this means in a few years we have got to consider adding another room to the Elementary School and of course another teacher. Our present debt on the building is \$9000 which means in three years we will complete payment on the new school.

I always enjoy visiting the Webster School, and I appreciate the cooperation of every one in town.
