Dear Elz

Today is a News day. Nothing happening.
Business as usual. Tomorrow is Saturday and a
football game at Camp Starby — the 2nd one I will
have seen all season — & the first since "D" Day
on Oct 4th. There will be a 3rd game for me
on Sunday at the same field.

Today at 5 PM for the first time in the
last month ~~the~~ we quit work at that hour.
After so long a time of working around the
clock, we will begin to have Saturday
noon & Sundays at our leisure. I will
certainly welcome this free time to catch
up on many things that had to go undone before.
For one thing I need a hair cut badly and hope
to get one tomorrow.

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Shaving Cream + other essential toilette items. Also took my dirty clothing to the laundry. Tomorrow I hope to take my dry cleaning too.

If things continue to slack off, I won't have much difficulty getting a leave in November. I hope to do some shopping in Yugoslavia + Germany both. But if I have to decide on just one place I don't know where it will be. Germany is less complicated to get in + out.

The troop ship arrived here from Trieste today. So most is all here now. Word has gone to DC for a haray up answer to what will become of trust personnel.

My radio will have to have a transformer. I hope to buy one tomorrow for \$3⁰⁰

Bought this "paper mate" pen at the PX today for \$0.75. Will contact the Skipper of the Hanti Victory tomorrow for

my pen.

I don't like this Hotel rooms I shall look about for a change but am in no hurry. The one I moved out cost \$2⁰⁰ per rate. The one I moved from in Varese cost \$5⁰⁰ per rate. We are on a station allowance of \$9⁰⁰ per day for 30 days. After that the allowance will drop to \$1⁵⁰ per day. This will not pay any hotel bill. We don't know what we will do then because no billets at Camp Starb and no mess have been provided for us. We eat at the Snack Bar or on the civilian economy which is exorbitant & out of bounds in price.

One meal cost an average of 1800 lire multiply this by 2½ meals per day and you get 5300 lire per day for food alone.

At 625 lire to the dollar this comes to roughly \$8.50 per day. So you can see that we will have a crisis on our hand when ~~the~~ the \$9⁰⁰ station allowance drops.
