To the inhabitants of the Town of Milan, in the County of Coos, in said State, qualified to vote in town affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at K. of P. hall at West Milan in said town on Tuesday the 9th day of March, next, at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary town officers for the ensuing year.
2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year, and make appropriation for the same.
3. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the repairs of highways and bridges for the ensuing year.
4. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for breaking roads winter of 1926 and 1927.
5. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for Trunk Line Construction.
6. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for Trunk Line Maintenance.
7. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for State Aid Maintenance.
8. To see if the town will vote to raise \$1,750.00 Special Muzzy Hill cut-off.
9. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for Memorial Day and appropriate the same to the Grand Army.
10. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for the purchase of books and supplies for the Public Library.
11. To choose by ballot one Trustee of Cemetery Trust Fund for three years.
12. To choose one trustee for Public Library for three years.
13. To see if the town will vote to discontinue the road on McWain Hill, with the understanding that the road be maintained by Tellington, by abating the taxes on the present valuation.
14. To see if the town will vote to discontinue the Police Court.
15. To see if the town will vote to accept the provisions of Chapter 87, Section 1, of the revised Statutes, on a section of the

Berlin-West Milan road, so called, and appropriate, or set aside from the amount raised for highway work the sum of \$150.00 for this purpose.

School Superintendent's Report

Milan, N. H., Feb. 1, 1926.

School Board of Milan, N. H.

Gentlemen:—

I hereby submit the annual report of the Superintendent of Schools. The writer took charge of your schools on July 1st, and this report will cover the work from then until February 1st.

Milan schools started in September with a very well balanced corps of teachers. Mrs. Myra S. Dunn resigned her position at the Hamlin school on account of illness in her family, and her position was taken by Miss Dorothy Enman without any interruption in the work.

I believe your schools to be working efficiently and progressively. Owing to the number and wide distribution it is not to be expected that all will accomplish the same amount of work, but careful inspection has shown that nearly all classes will complete the requirements. I contemplate no radical changes this year as former supt. Walton S. Adams left the schools in excellent condition, but as educational thought progresses we shall change methods from time to time to the end that your boys and girls may have equal opportunities with all children in the State.

The Superintendent has emphasized character and the value of education to the children in all the schools. He believes that our modern complex life has crowded so many things into our curriculum that character tends to be assumed rather than actual. It is only through the individual character of the coming citizen that the nation can live and endure.
