

TOWN WARRANT

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Bridgewater in the County of Grafton in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at Grange Hall in said Bridgewater on Tuesday, the Ninth day of March, next to act upon the following subjects:

Polls to be open from 11:00 A. M. to 7:00 P. M.

Business Meeting at 8:00 P. M.

1. To choose a Selectman for three (3) years and all other necessary Town Officers.

2. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$421.97 for T.R.A., provided that the State contributes the sum of \$2,813.11.

3. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate to defray the cost of a complete revaluation of the taxable property in Bridgewater by the State Tax Commission.

4. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for Expenses for the current year as estimated in the budget, except Highways and Bridges.

5. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and apppropriate for Highways and Bridges for the current year. 6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,312.91 for payment of principal and interest on long term notes.

7. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,500 for Town Road Construction.

8. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow in the name of the Town a sum of money not to exceed \$3,000, for a period of not more than (2) years, for the purpose of Town Road Construction.

9. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen with the concurrance of the Highway Advisory Committee to sell any Highway Equipment not in use by the Road Agent.

10. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of taxes.

11. To transact any further business that may legally come before said meeting.

Financial Condition:

As shown in the Auditor's report the financial condition of the town changed from a deficit of \$210.26 in 1963 to a surplus of \$1,085.72. The total of long term notes now outstanding is \$3,226.00. Payments against this debt in fiscal 1965 include \$1,000.00 for the final payment on the G. M. C. truck, \$700.00 on the Jeep truck, and \$500.00 on the grader.

Highway Department:.

The highway improvement project on Whittemore Point near the Curley residence was completed with a mix-in-place treatment. The total cost was \$400.38. A balance of \$1,099.62 was therefore left in the Highway Improvement Appropriation which was intended to be expended on Whittemore Point Drive. After careful consideration the Selectmen felt that the available amount of money was insufficient for the purpose and that a certain amount of the material in the present roadbed should be removed. As the site for the Highway Garage needs considerable fill it was decided to postpone action on both projects until next year.

The Highway Committee and the Selectmen decided to purchase the Caterpillar 210 Grader from the City of Franklin. Details of the expenditure are in another section. The Road Agent reports that the machine is very helpful in his work and use of the snow wing will relieve the crawler tractor on the hard surfaced roads in the town.

Fire Department:

Despite another season of very little rainfall and unusually dry conditions no forest fires were experienced in Bridgewater. This speaks highly of the cooperation of the public in using the town dump facilities instead of burning debris at home.

Buildings lost by fire on the River Road included a dwelling and barn owned by Elwood Perkins and a summer cottage owned by Henry & Rosemond Raymond.

The Bristol Fire Department was called twice on the West Side of town, one for a truck fire on Whittemore Point Drive and for a suspected chimney fire at the Flaherty cottage on Route 3A.

The Forestry truck answered three calls for fires at the Town Dump and a chimney fire at the home of Reginald Morrill, the chimney fire being contained at no cost to the Town.

Revaluation:

For the fourth consecutive year the Selectmen are asking that the Town Meeting appropriate funds for a complete revaluation by the state Tax Commission.

The primary concern of the Selectmen in this matter is that certain properties in the town may be overassessed as well as many properties that we know to be underassessed. Property values change from time to time due to changing economic and social conditions. Such changes have been rapid in Bridgewater and are nearly impossible for the Selectmen to keep pace with over the last twelve years.

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS & RECOMMENDATIONS

Gentlemen :

Submitted herewith is the report of the annual examination and audit of the accounts of the Town of Bridgewater for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1964, which was made by this Division in accordance with the vote of the Town. Exhibits as hereafter listed are included as part of the report.

Scope of Audit

Included in the examination and audit were the accounts and records of the Board of Selectmen, Treasurer, Tax Collector, Town Clerk, Road Agent and Trustees of Trust Funds.

Financial Statements

Comparative Balance Sheets -December 31, 1963 — December 31, 1964: (Exhibit A-1)

Comparative Balance Sheets as of December 31, 1963 and December 31, 1964, are presented in Exhibit A-1. As indicated therein, the Net Debt decreased by \$69.98 in 1964.

Analysis of Change in Financial Condition: (Exhibit A-2)

An analysis of the change in financial condition of the Town during the year is made in Exhibit A-2, with the factors which caused the change indicated therein. These were as follows:

Comparative Statements of Appropriations & Expenditures -Estimated & Actual Revenues: (Exhibits A-3 & A-4)

Comparative statements of appropriations and expenditures, estimated and actual revenues for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1964, are presented in Exhibits A-3 and A-4. As indicated by the budget summary (Exhibit A-4), a revenue surplus of \$526.82, plus a net unexpended balance of appropriations of \$789.66, resulted in a net budget surplus of \$1,316.48.

Summary Statement of Receipts & Expenditures: (Exhibit B-1)

A summary statement of receipts and expenditures for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1964, made up in accordance with the uniform classification of accounts, is included in Exhibit B-1. Proof of the Treasurer's balance as of December 31, 1964, is indicated in Exhibit B-2.

Statement of Long Term Indebtedness: (Exhibit F)

A statement of outstanding long term indebtedness as of December 31, 1964, showing annual debt service requirements, is contained in Exhibit F.

Audit Procedure

The accounts and records of all town officials charged with the custody, receipt and disbursement of public funds were examined and audited. Vouchers and cancelled checks were compared with supporting invoices and payrolls as well as entries in the books of record. Receipts were checked by source insofar as possible and totals of receipts and expenditures verified. Book balances were verified by comparison with reconciled bank balances made from statements obtained from depository banks. Verification of uncollected taxes was made by mailing notices to delinquent taxpayers as indicated by the Collector's records. The amounts of uncollected and unredeemed taxes as indicated in this report are therefore subject to any changes which may be necessitated by the return of verification notices.

General Comments

Current (Deficit) - Surplus:

The current financial condition of the Town changed from a current deficit (excess of current liabilities over total assets) of \$210.26, to a current surplus (excess of total assets over current liabilities) of \$1,085.72, in 1964, as shown herewith:

Record of Tax Sales:

The Tax Collector should adopt the use of the standard loose leaf "Record of Tax Sales" form. Each property sold at tax sale should be recorded therein, indicating the date of sale, name of taxpayer, year of levy and amount for which property was sold - including taxes, interest and costs to date of sale. Subsequently, when redemptions are made from the tax sale, the appropriate information should be recorded. Surety Bond:

The surety bond of the Town Treasurer should be increased from \$8,000.00 to \$10,000.00.

Conclusion:

The provisions of Chapter 184, of the Laws of 1955, require that this report or the summary of findings and recommendations (letter of transmittal) shall be published in the next annual report of the Town.

We extend our thanks to the officials of the Town of Bridgewater for their assistance during the course of the audit.

FIRE WARDEN'S REPORT

The 1964 forest fire season surpassed the record year of 1963 in both length and severity. For the second successive year, we experienced a rainfall deficiency of more than ten inches and the compounding of such drought conditions, together with the many days of strong, drv winds, characterized 1964 as one of the most hazardous years in the past half century. Although our fire season was three weeks longer than that of 1963, the number of fires showed only a slight increase and more remarkable was the fact that the area burned dropped from 2280 acres in 1963 to 900 acres in 1964. Early detection and rapid response kept many potential fire disasters from becoming reality. We all owe a debt of gratitude to the men in this community who responded and fought our fires so efficiently. Our state is now 86% wooded and its economy-both industrial and recreational—is greatly dependent on this forest resource. The responsibility for adequate fire protection of this great area -4,350.00 acres-is everyone's responsibility and prevention is one of our most effective tools.

Prevention is good common sense.

- 1. Take your rubbish to the town dump. If you must burn, obtain a permit and watch your fire until it is dead out.
- Instruct your children in fire safety. Keep matches from young children. Explain to them the dangers of lighting matches and making outdoor fires.

 Be sure discarded smoking material and matches are out. A major portion of our preventable fires this year are chargeable to three causes: (1) permit fires allowed to escape; (2) children playing with matches; and (3) smokers. Let's be mindful of the fact that all such fires endanger property and lives.

We wish to thank you for your very fine cooperation during the past fire season and with your continued cooperation we are confident that we can improve our fire record in 1965.
