WARRANT

THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Colebrook, in the County of Coos, in the State of New Hampshire, qualified to vote in town affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Town of Colebrook on Tuesday, the 14th day of March, next, at ten o'clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

- 1. To bring in your ballots for the election of Town Officers to be elected by ballot for the Town of Colebrook for the ensuing year.
- 2. To act upon all of the following articles contained in this Warrant.
- 3. To see if the Town will instruct its Selectmen to appoint all other Town Officers as required by law.
- 4. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for the General Government Expenses for the ensuing year.
- 5. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for the Police for the ensuing year.
- 6. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for Civilian Defense for the ensuing year.
- 7. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise as a contribution to Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital Association.
- 8. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise as a contribution to the North Country Community Services, Inc.
- 9. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to appropriate for Care, Removal, andlor re-

placement of Trees.

- 10. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for Sewer Maintenance for the ensuing year.
- 11. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for maintenance of the Town Dump for the ensuing year.
- 12. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for maintenance of Summer and Winter Roads for the ensuing year.
- 13. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for Street Lighting for the ensuing year.
- 14. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for the General Expense of the Highway Department for the ensuing year.
- 15. To see if the Town will raise the sum of \$948.33 for maintenance, construction, or reconstruction of Class V highways, in which event the State will contribute \$6,322.21.
- 16. To see if the Town will vote to remove the snow from the business area of the village, defining the area to be cleared, and to raise money for the same.
- 17. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for Plowing and Sanding Sidewalks, for the ensuing year.
- 18. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for support of the Town Library for the ensuing year.
- 19. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the support of the Town Poor for the ensuing year.
- 20. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for Old Age Assistance for the ensuing year.

- 21. To see if the Town will vote to raise the sum of \$300.00 for the observance of Memorial Day and care of the Monument Lot.
- 22. To see if the Town will vote to maintain a free skating rink for the ensuing year, and to raise money necessary for same.
- 23. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for Hydrant Rental for the ensuing year.
- 24. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for care of Cemeteries for the ensuing year.
- 25. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate to the Colebrook and North Country Chamber of Commerce, for the purpose of publicizing and promoting, by advertising folders and otherwise, the Town and the North Country Region.
- 26. To see if the Town will vote and appropriate the sum of \$505.88 to the White Mountain Region Association, being .07c per \$1,000.00 of equalized valuation, for the purpose of issuing and distributing printed matter and advertising and otherwise publicizing the advantages of the Town, in cooperation with the other 45 towns in the region.
- 27. To see if the Town will vote to raise the sum of \$1,500.00 for the construction of sidewalks in accordance with the vote at the 1951 Town Meeting, for the ensuing year.
- 28. To see what sum of money the Town will appropriate for Cleaning Streets in the business area this summer, and to authorize the Selectmen to withdraw the amount voted, from the Parking Meter Fund.
- 29. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for Tarring Streets.
- 30. To see if the Town will vote to reconstruct and improve Spring Street and to raise money for

- the same, and to direct the Selectmen to place any unexpended balance in a special fund to be used for the same purpose in later years.
- 31. To see what sum of money the Town will vote for Sewer and Storm Drain Construction, and to direct the Selectmen to place any unexpended balance in a special fund to be used for this same purpose in later years.
- 32. To see if the Town will authorize the Water Commission to construct a six-inch hydrant line from the end of the present line near the Charles J. Lewis' property on Pleasant Street to the location of the proposed plant site on the Mohawk Road providing the plant is actually constructed and the Commissioners and the Plant Management agree upon the water rates and terms of the water contract.
- 33. If the above Article 32 is approved, to see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to raise the necessary funds, not to exceed twenty-five thousand dollars, by issuing bonds or long-term notes.
- 34. To see what sum of money the Town will raise to pay the principal on the bond issue for the Sewerage Facilities.
- 35. To see if the Town will vote to give free use of the Town Hall to public schools in said Town for school purposes, including heat, lights, and janitor services, whenever same does not conflict with the best interest of the Town, for the ensuing year.
- 36. To see if the Town will vote to give free use of the Town Hall to non-profit organizations, including heat, lights, and janitor services, whenever the same does not conflict with the best interests of the Town, and at the discretion of the Selectmen, for the ensuing year.
- 37. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money to defray the expenses of the Town in anticipation of taxes, for

the ensuing year.

- 38. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to sell at public auction any real estate acquired by the Town through Tax Collector's deeds, and until such sale is made, to administer the property in the best interest of the Town.
- 39. To see if the Town will vote to accept, ratify and confirm the reports of Agents, Selectmen, Auditors, and all other Town Officers, as contained in the Annual Report of the said Town for the year ending December 31, 1966.
- 40. To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.Given under our hands and seals this 18th day of

The year 1966 saw the Colebrook Water Works extend the existing water line by adding Edwards Street to the Colebrook water system. We also replaced the water line on Cross Street with new pipe.

For those who may be interested or have any questions, the Water Commissioners meet the first Wednesday of the month at 8:00 P. M in the Selectmen's Room at the Town Hall.
