Library Report.

To the Citizens of the Town of Gilford:

Pursuant to the usual custom, the trustees of the Gilford public library submit this, their annual report, together with that of the treasurer of the library funds for the year ending February 15, 1907.

The library now contains 1,777 volumes; added since last report, 116 volumes; 103 volumes have been purchased with the annual appropriation and 13 volumes have been given to the library. The total number of volumes loaned the past year has been 1,697, classed as follows: Fiction, 1,659; history, 15; general literature, 2; travels, 5; art, 1; poetry, 3; biography, 12. The largest number of volumes loaned in any one day, 50.

Twelve new names have been added to the list of patrons of the library during the year.

Donations have been made to the library as follows: Mr. Otis A. Rowe, 1 vol.; Mr. Simon Rowe, 2 vols.; Mrs. Wilbur F. Morrill, 1 vol.; Hon. Frank W. Rollins, Concord, 1 vol.; from the state, 2 vols. United States, 5 vols.

We have retained twenty dollars of your appropriation in anticipation of the arrival of a work entitled, "Genealogies of New Hampshire Families," for which we have subscribed. As many public libraries expend a portion of their funds for periodicals, your trustees decided to try this plan in connection with your library. On the first of last October, we placed subscriptions for ten of the leading magazines and opened the library as a reading room during the usual library hours. Thus far the reading table has been well patronized. Such periodicals contain the best and most up-to-date reading, and when substantially bound can be loaned, as other books. We wish our citizens, as a whole, would make a greater use of the library. Try and interest your children in the same. It is one of the best things you can do for them. In closing this report, we wish to here thank all who have contributed,

and especially the tax payers who have accorded such liberal support to the library in the past.

Let us encourage them as much as possible. We wish to thank all those who have assisted in any way to make the past school year a success.
