## THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

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To the Inhabitants of the Town of Ellsworth in the County of Grafton, in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town House in said Ellsworth on Tuesday, the 12th day of March, next at 10:30 of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same.
3. To see how much money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for the support of Highways and Bridges.
4. To see if the town will vote to qualify for T.R.A. and raise and appropriate \$80.65 for same.
5. To determine and appoint the salaries of the town officers and make appropriation of the same.
6. To see if the town will vote to support the White Mt. Regions Association and raise and appropriate \$11.32 for same.
7. To see how much money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for Employees Social Security.
8. To see how much money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for the support of the town house.

9. To see if the town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of taxes.

10. To see if the town will vote to accept the reports of agents and officers.

11. To see if the town will vote to accept as a gift from Mrs. R. S. Yeaton a strip of land 33 ft. wide more or less, running from the shore of Ellsworth Pond to the Pond road so called.

12. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for the use of the Bicentennial Committee.

13. To see what wages the town will vote to pay Highway Employees.

14. To see how much money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for Welfare Costs.

15. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.

**REPORT OF FOREST FIRE WARDEN  
AND DISTRICT CHIEF**

After several successive years of drought, the rains of 1967 came as a welcome change. Our record of the past fire season is good. Our thanks to all who contributed to achieve this good record. Continued improvement in the matter of accurate, prompt detection and rapid effective suppression action can help to maintain this good, worthwhile record even though we do not have an abundance of rain as in the fire season of 1967.

It will help if we follow these simple suggestions :

1. No burning of debris and waste between the hours of 9:00 A. M. and 5:00 P. M. and then only with a written permit from the Forest Fire Warden.

2. Take debris and waste to the town dump.

3. Maintain a clean, safe dump.

4. Keep matches away from young children.

5. Be sure matches and smoking material are dead out when we discard them.

6. Set good example for others in fire prevention.
