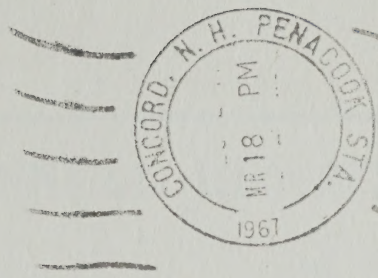

WARRANT for the ANNUAL TOWN MEETING

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Webster in the County of Merrimack in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at Grange Hall in said Webster on Tuesday, the Fourteenth day of March, next at ten of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
2. To raise such sums of money as maybe necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same.
3. To raise and appropriate such sums of money as may be necessary for maintenance of highway and bridges.
  - a. Summer Maintenance
  - b. Winter Maintenance
  - c. Tar Roads
  - d. General Expense of Highway Department
  - e. Street Lighting
4. To raise and appropriate the sum of \$581.12 for class V road construction.
5. To raise and appropriate such sums of money as may be necessary for Public Welfare.
6. To raise and appropriate such sums of money as may be necessary for the support of the Town Library.
7. To raise and appropriate such sums of money as may be necessary for Patriotic purposes.
  - a. Old Home Day
  - b. Memorial Day
8. To raise and appropriate such sums of money as may be necessary for the support and maintenance of the Hy-Mar Fire Department, including forest fires.

9. To see what sum the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the care of cemeteries.

10. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$136.80 for use in connection with the state program for the eradication of White Pine Blister Rust.

11. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$80.00 toward the operating deficit of the Concord Hospital, this being based on the number of patients admitted from Webster.

12. To authorize and empower the Board of Selectmen to borrow for the Town, by issuance of notes, a sum not exceeding \$40,000.00 in anticipation of taxes for the year 1967, said notes payable from said taxes within one year from date of issuance, and to authorize the Board of Selectmen to determine the rate of interest on such notes and to provide for the sale thereof.

13. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$300.00 for the maintenance of the playground.

14. To see if the Town will vote to raise \$25.00 to be expended in cooperation with the New Hampshire Forestry and Recreation Commission for the opening and maintaining of the old trails and old roads for forest fire protection. The New Hampshire Forestry and Recreation Commission to provide a matching sum.

15. To see what action the Town wishes to take in regards to the disposal of money received from the sale of Town land.

16. To see if the Town will vote to buy a blade plow for snow removal. This money to be spent from the Highway Equipment Fund.

17. To see what action the Town wishes to take in regards to the purchase of a new cab and chassis for the Fire Department. Part of the cost of this truck to come from the use of the Trust Fund for Future Fire Equipment. The balance of the cost to be raised and appropriated.

18. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000.00 to be added to the Future Fire Equipment Fund.



19. To see if the Town will vote to purchase the Grange Hall and real estate from the Daniel Webster Grange for the price of \$7,500.00. Further it is stipulated in the agreement of purchase that a stage shall be built and that the Daniel Webster Grange shall have a life time lease, rent free, for regular meetings and other grange functions. All money spent regarding this article shall be used from the Town Hall Fund.

20. To see if the Town will vote to spend a sum not to exceed \$10,000.00 from the Town Hall Fund and the Future Town Building Fund for the purpose of adding a stage, Library and Selectmen's Office to the Grange Hall.

21. To see if the Town will vote to spend a sum not to exceed \$5,000.00 from the Town Hall Fund for the purpose of adding a stage to the Grange Hall.

22. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$500.00 annually, for the purpose of renting the Grange Hall from the Daniel Webster Grange.

23. To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.

## Report of Forest Fire Warden & District Chief

Fire records are made by people — those who cause fires and those who control them. Your forest fire warden, deputy wardens, fire chief and firemen have, in spite of a prolonged drought, made one of the best fire control records in recent years. Despite a very dry spring, we in New Hampshire working together, have substantially reduced our fire incidence (885 in 1965 to 595 in 1966.)

This enviable record is largely due to two factors:

1. A closely coordinated and integrated state-town organization jointly carrying out programs of forest fire prevention, training and suppression with dedicated personnel.

2. Your appreciation of our forest fire control program and your individual effort in practicing fire prevention.

Statistics show, however, there is room for improvement. Major problems are still with us; (1) the careless disposal of cigarettes; (2) the householder's carelessness in burning rubbish; (3) the failure of woodlot owners and contractors to completely extinguish their brush burning fires; (4) failure to extinguish camp fires; (5) unsupervised children playing with matches.

New Hampshire has 4,339,000 acres of woodland to be protected. In 1966 we experienced 595 forest fires on this area and restricted acreage burned to 395 acres — a fine testimonial to the efficiency and dedication of the men who make up our forest fire control organization.

1. If you must burn you will need a permit. Permits are not issued between 9:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. except on rainy days. Permits are not needed when the ground is covered with snow. To minimize risk the best way to dispose of rubbish is at your authorized town or municipal dumping area.

2. Be sure all discarded smoking material is out.

3. Don't leave a live camp or cooking fire.

4. Most important — Instruct your children that matches are not playthings.

## Cemetery Commission

The Cemetery Commission was formed in May, 1966.

We have measured and mapped the "New" part in the back section of Courser Hill.

Everyone that has been buried within the last year has been marked according to lot and grave.

We are in the process of setting up a card system that will be filed by lot number with names of the persons in that lot on it. We will also have the names alphabetically listed.

We are called on to have graves ready for burial, check that in some of the older lots that there is room, measure and set stakes for corner stones and monuments, and go to the cemetery with anyone interested in picking out a lot.

We have broken the 6 grave lots into two - 2 grave lots and a walk between for several families.

We realize that these cemeteries need a lot of things done with them and it is going to take time and money in some instances before everything that we would like done is accomplished.

The Cemetery Commission would like to obtain more land so Riverdale Cemetery can be enlarged. There are very few graves left in the present cemetery. We haven't inquired about the availability of the land to the south of the present cemetery or directly across the road. We realize there is a gully in the land to the south.

To obtain cemetery lots without cost in Webster you have to be either a resident or a property taxpayer.

Corner stones shall be placed on all lots spoken for. The top will be flat with an initial.

All corner stones and head stones will be flush with the ground.

Shrubs shall be trimmed at the discretion of the commissioners.

Trust funds will be gladly received in any amount from residents and property taxpayers and required from anyone else at the following rate: 2 grave lot - \$200

4 grave lot - \$400

6 grave lot - \$600
